


Former US Secretary of Defense General James Mattis delivered remarks at a Ramadan majlis hosted by HH Sheikh Mohamed bin Zayed in Abu Dhabi.

Mr. Mattis described the US and UAE strategic relationship as "broad enough, deep enough and strong enough to withstand any temporary challenges of any sort."

Over the past three decades, UAE and US military forces have teamed up on six coalition actions, from the First Gulf War to the fight against ISIS. Last month, the UAE and US entered a new Defense Cooperation Agreement.
