UAE Celebrates Women's Progress and Empowerment on Emirati Women's Day

Today, the UAE celebrates Emirati Women's Day in recognition of the achievements and contributions women have made in all sectors of UAE society. Women in the UAE play leading roles in business, government, the arts and sports.

The UAE leads Arab countries in terms of gender balance, according to an annual index issued by the United Nations Development Program (UNDP). Women make up 30 percent of the UAE Cabinet.

The UAE also ranks high globally in terms of gender equality for literacy and pay equity, according to a report from the World Economic Forum in 2018. In addition, 77 percent of Emirati women enroll in higher education after secondary school, and women make up 70 percent of all university graduates in the UAE.

"Emirati women have played a central role to help the UAE become the inclusive, innovative and prosperous nation it is today," said Shaima Gargash, Deputy Chief of Mission at the UAE Embassy in Washington, DC. "I am proud to work with such a strong team of women here at the Embassy in Washington."
