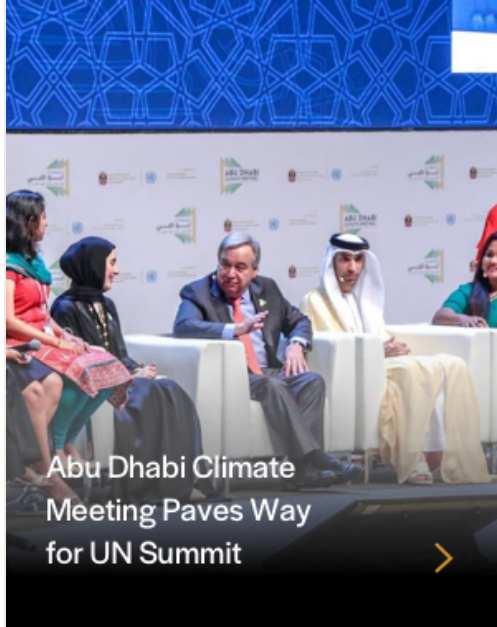

UAE Encourages Inclusion and Coexistence at 2nd US State Department Ministerial

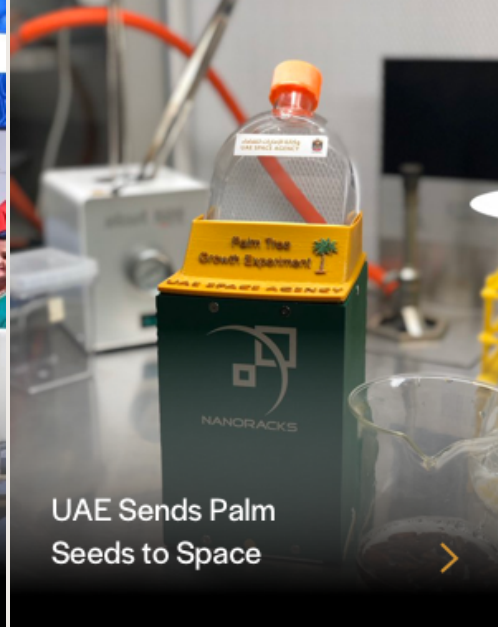

On August 17, 2004, Sheikh Ahmed Al Maktoum won the UAE's first ever Olympic medal, claiming gold in men's double trap shooting at the 2004 Games in Athens. Twelve years later, at the 2016 Games in Rio de Janeiro, judoka Sergiu Toma won the UAE's second medal – taking bronze in the men's 81kg judo tournament.
