UAE Foreign Minister Participates in Historic Trilateral Meeting

UAE Foreign Minister His Highness Sheikh Abdullah bin Zayed Al Nahyan recently <u>concluded a visit</u> to Washington, DC, where he met with US Secretary of State Anthony Blinken and Israeli Alternate Prime Minister and Foreign Minister Yair Lapid. The historic trilateral meeting between the senior diplomats <u>built upon</u> <u>the Abraham Accords</u>, which normalized UAE relations with Israel. Sheikh Abdullah also met with senior Members of Congress, analysts and leaders from prominent American Jewish organizations.

The meetings led to the <u>formation of two new trilateral working</u> <u>groups</u> on coexistence and sustainable food and water systems.

In October 1985, Emirates Airline flew its <u>inaugural flight</u> from Dubai to Karachi, Pakistan.
