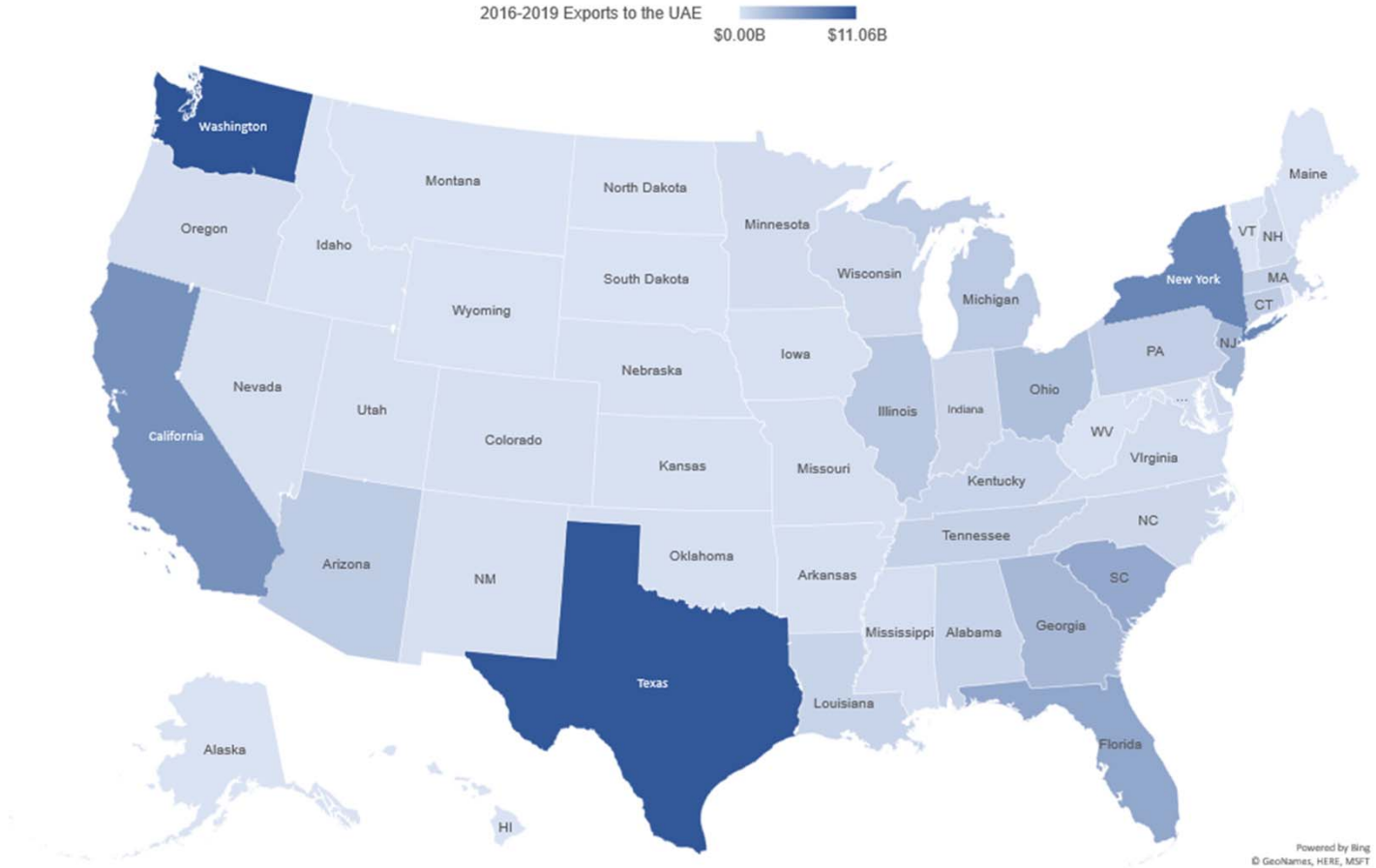

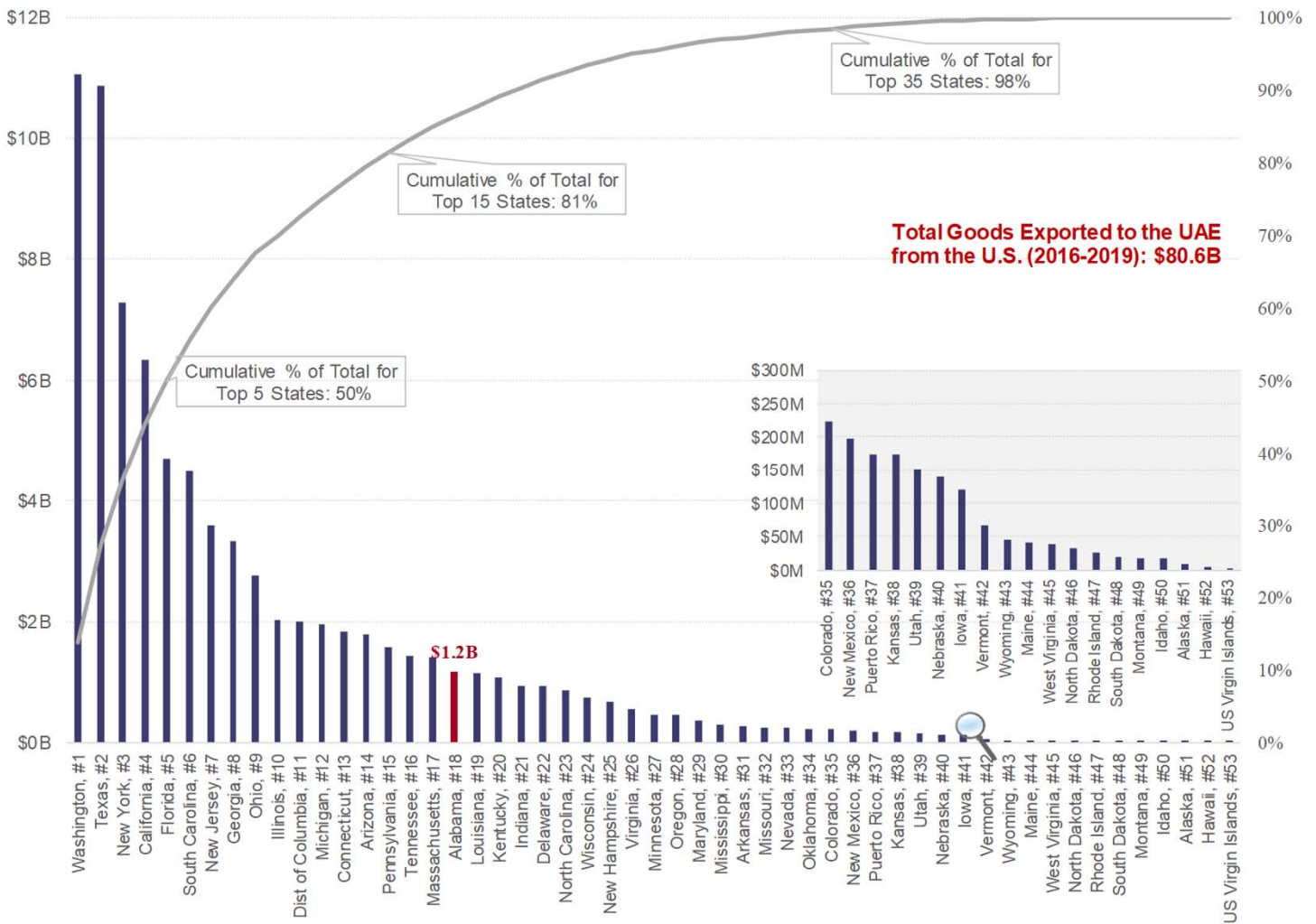

Exhibit I.1 | U.S. State Rankings of Exports to the UAE (\$ in Billions)

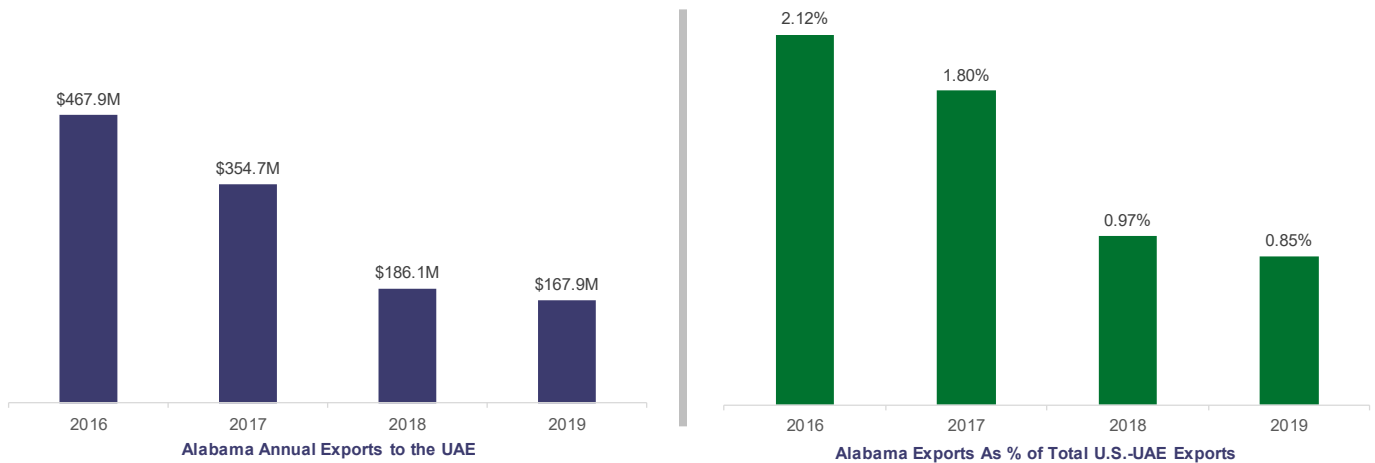

Exhibit I.2 | Alabama Export Values and Percent of Total by Year



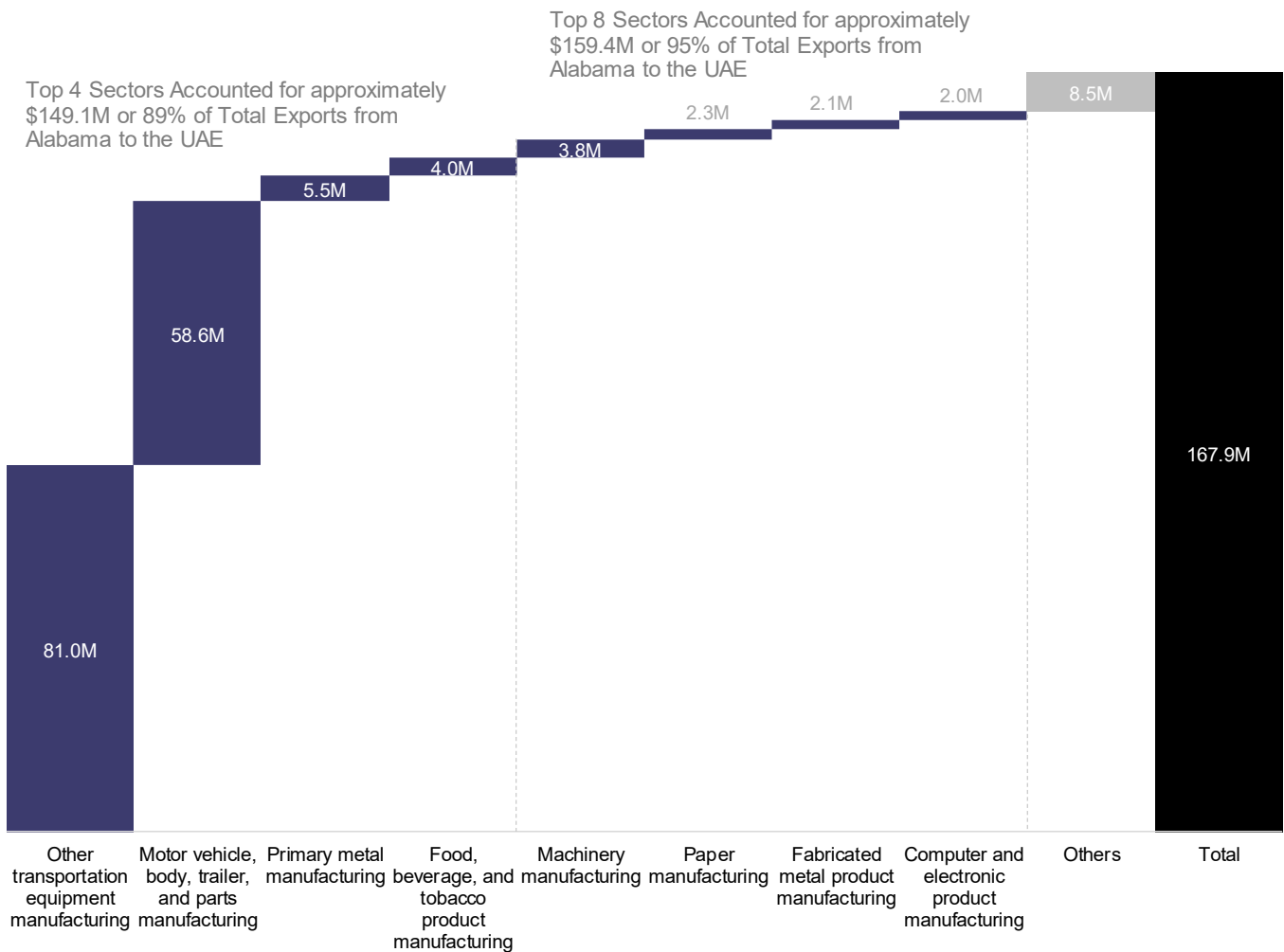

Exhibit I.3 | Alabama's Exporting Sectors in 2019



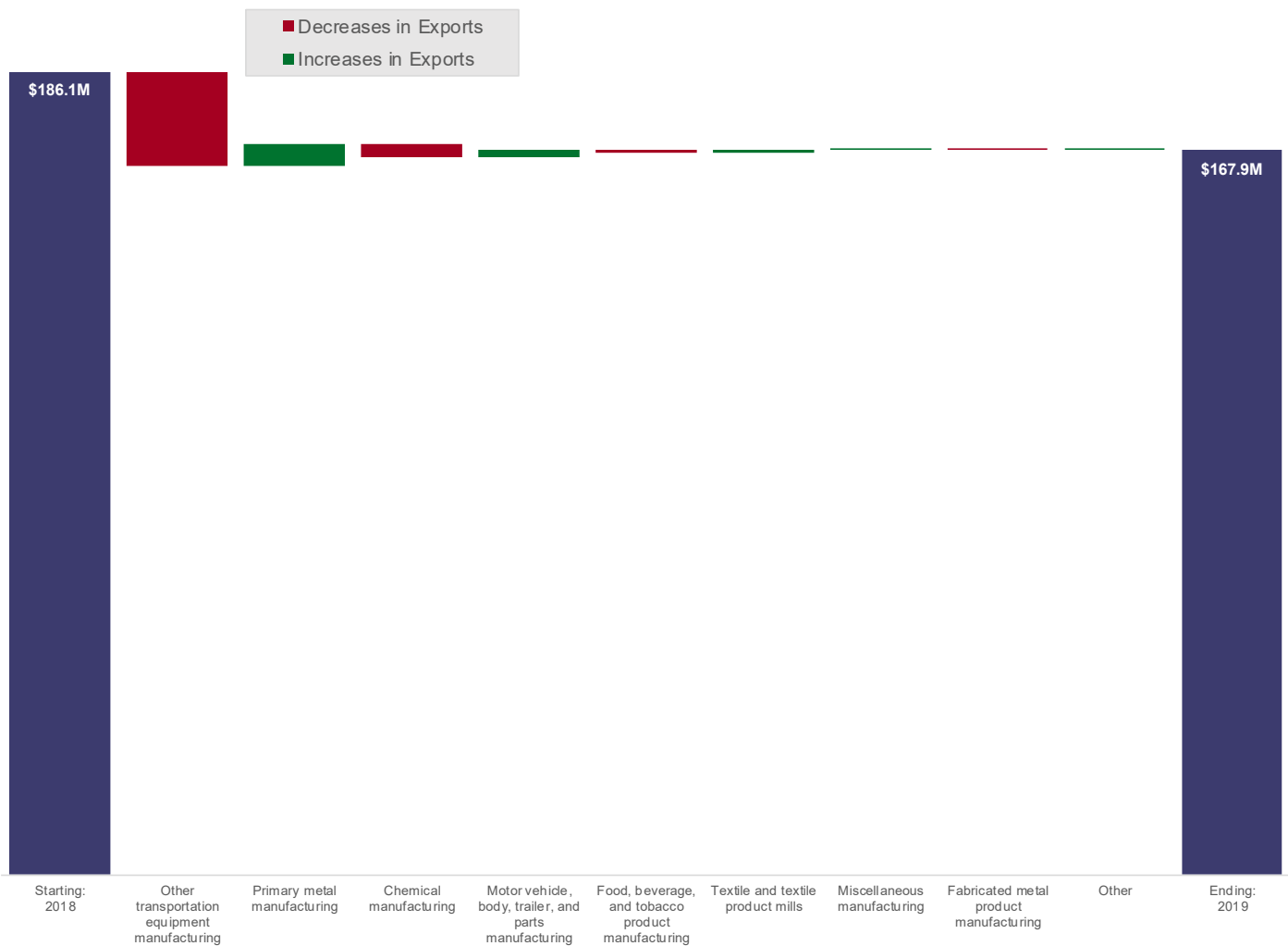

Exhibit I.4 | Alabama's Exporting Sector Movements From 2018 to 2019

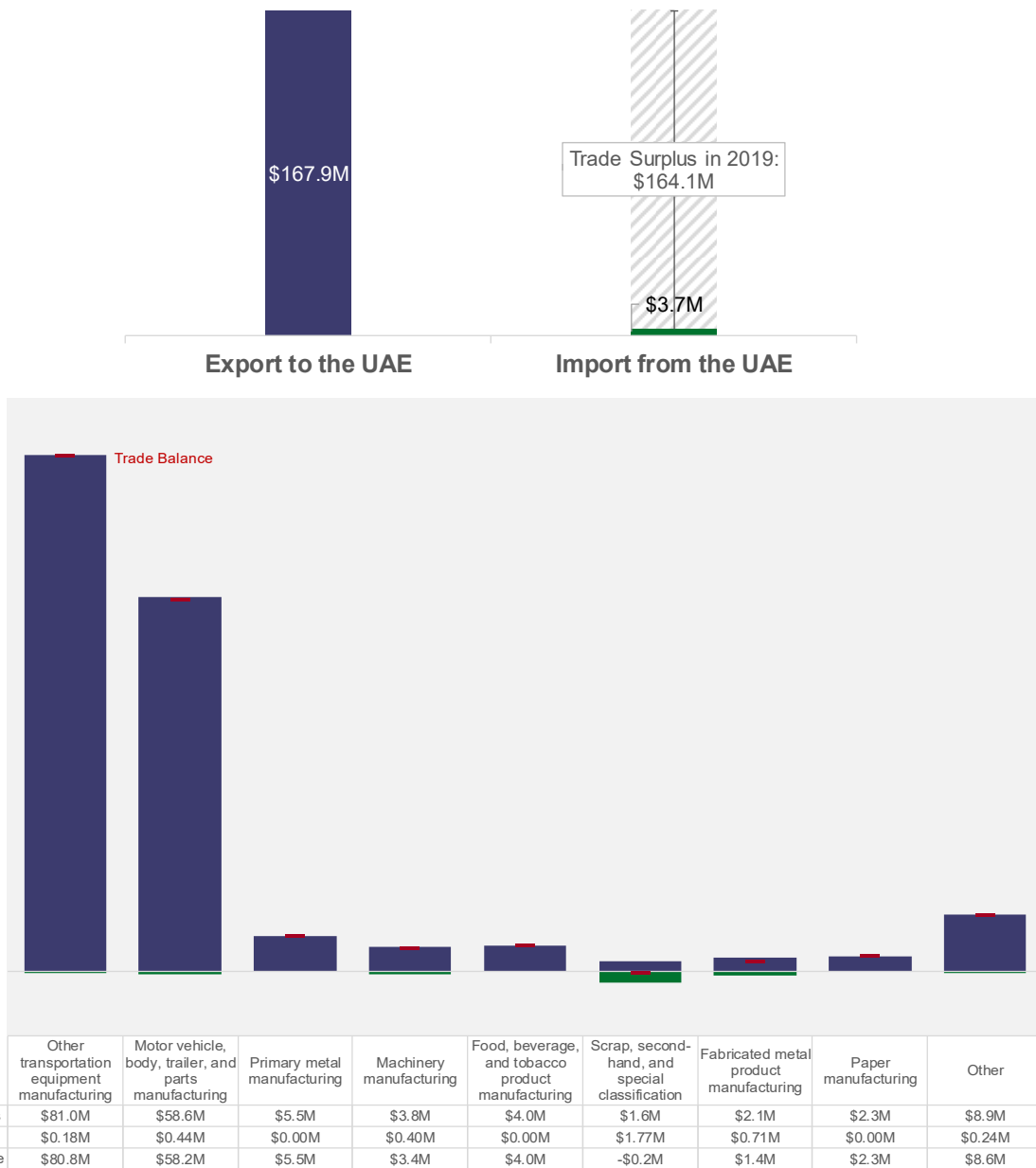

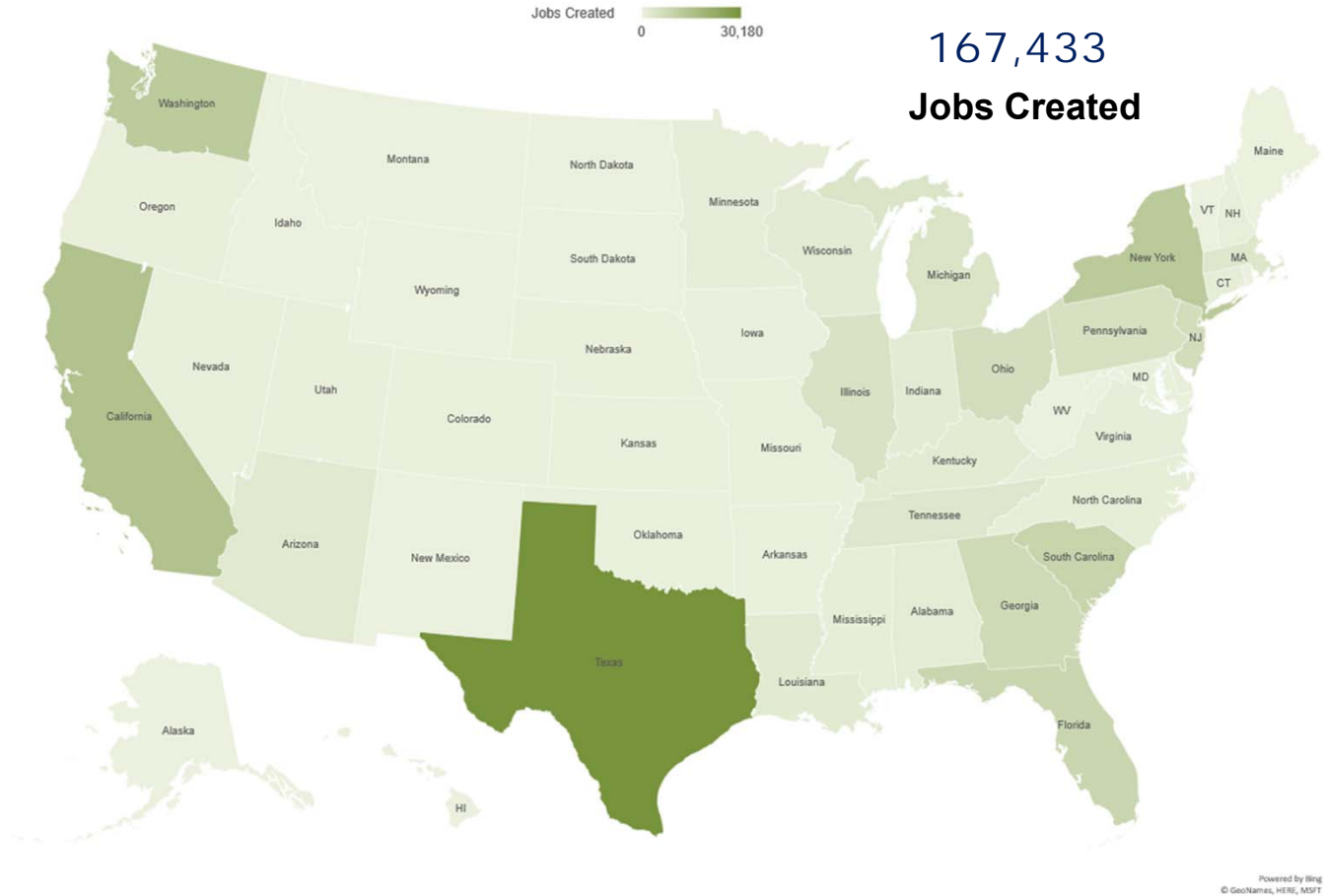
Exhibit I.5 | Alabama's Trade Surplus with the UAE by Sector
