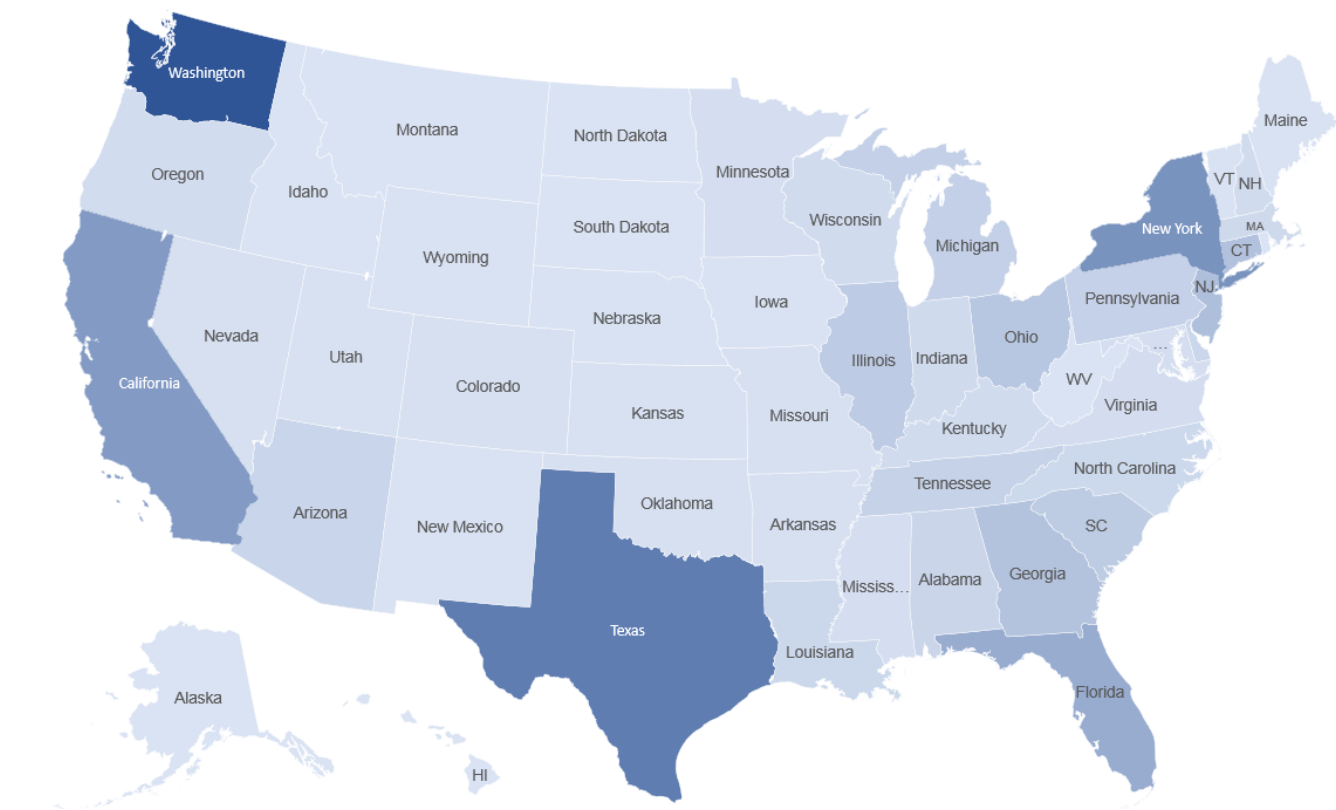

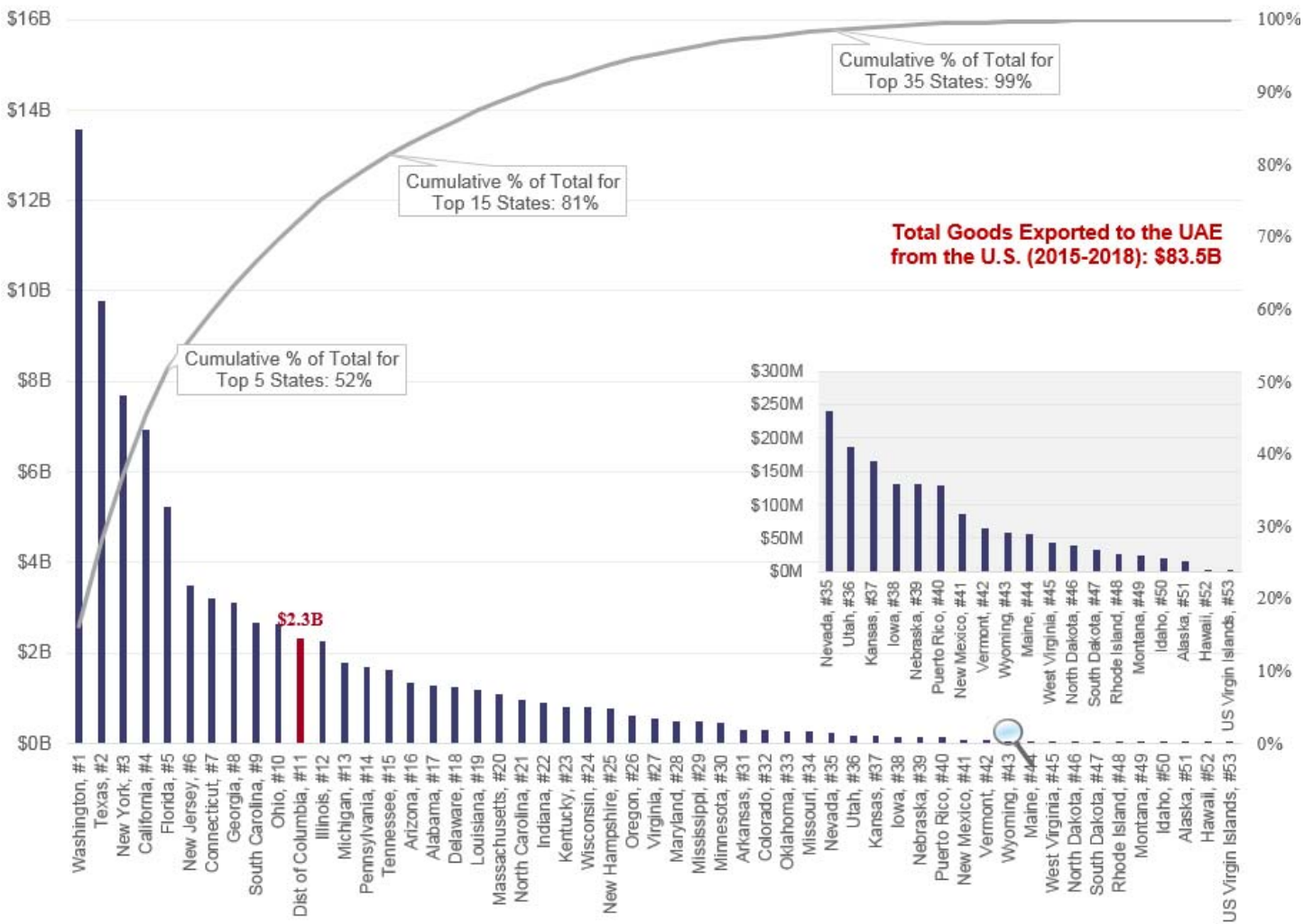

Exhibit I.1 | U.S. State Rankings of Exports to the UAE (\$ in Billions)



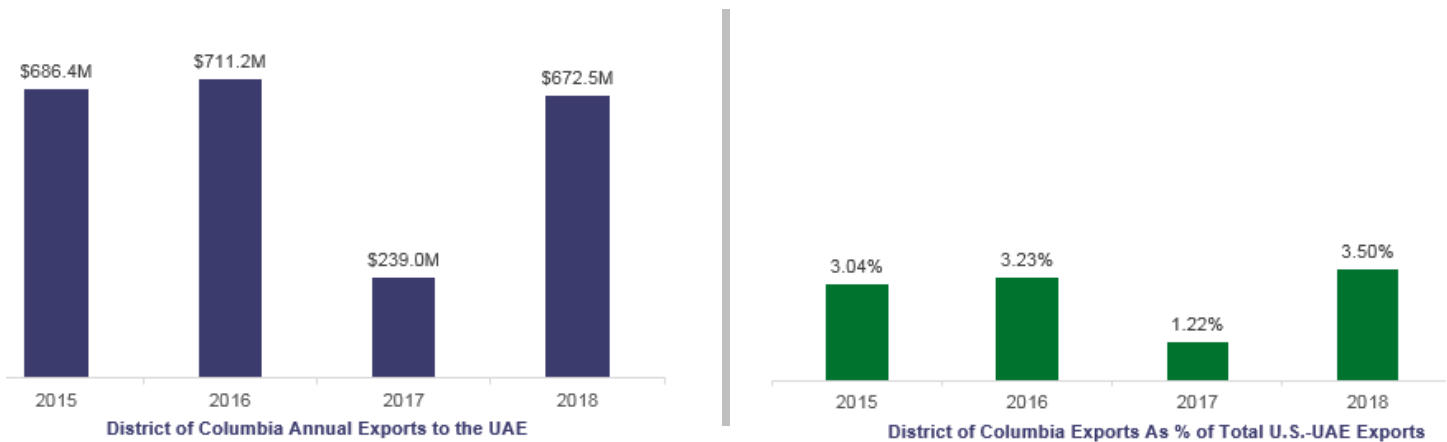

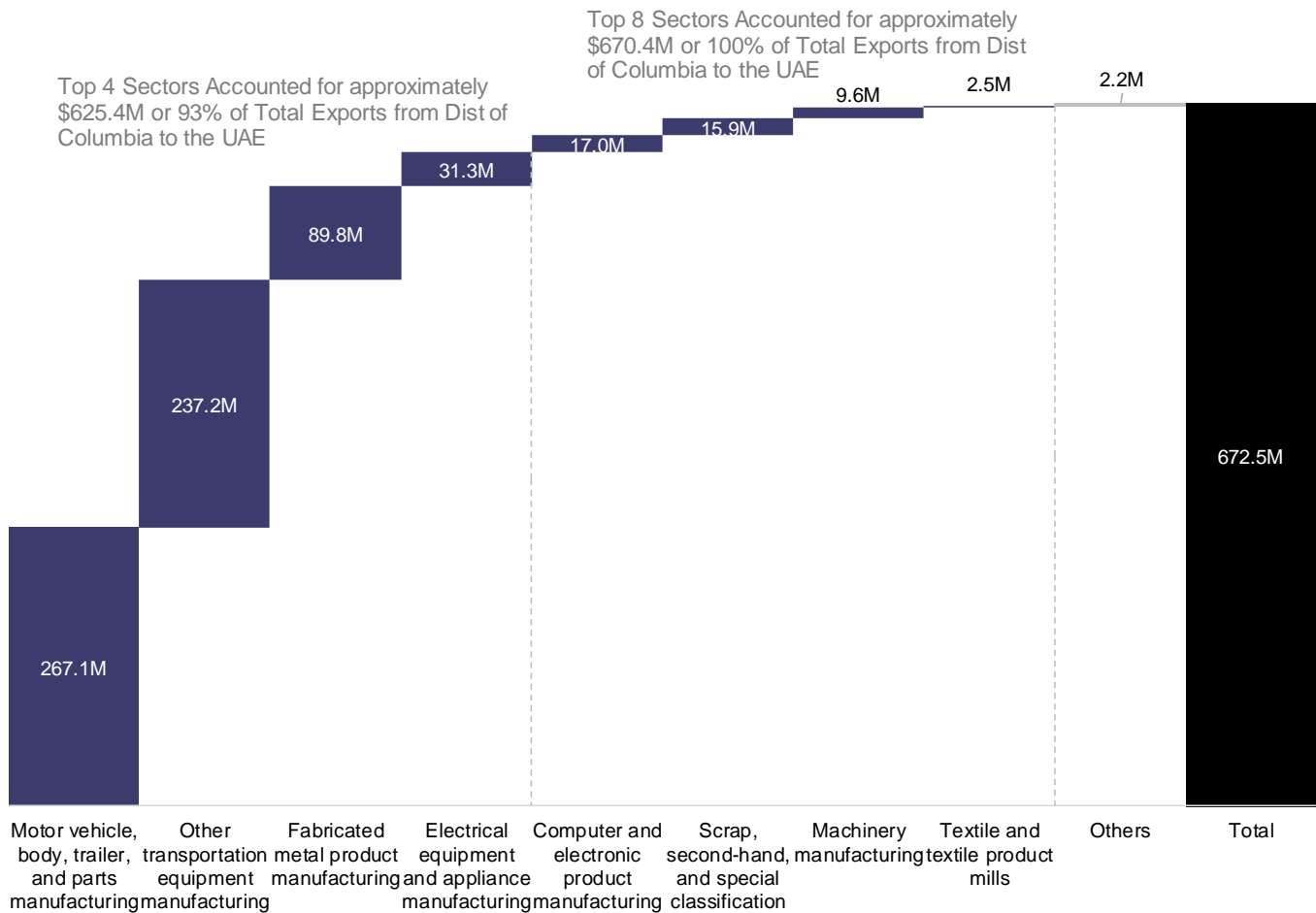

Exhibit I.3 | District of Columbia's Exporting Sectors in 2018

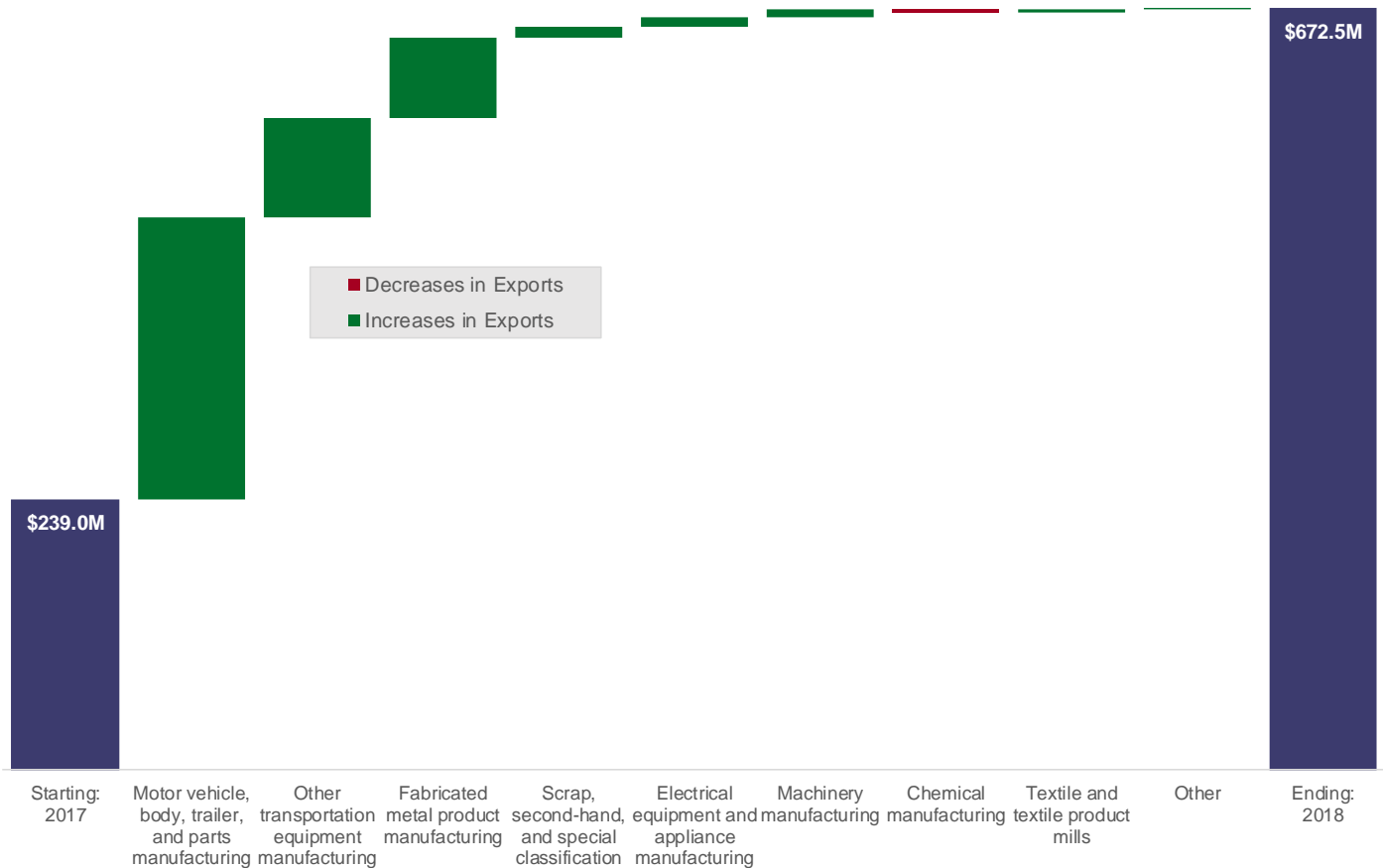

Exhibit I.4 | District of Columbia's Exporting Sector Movements From 2017 to 2018

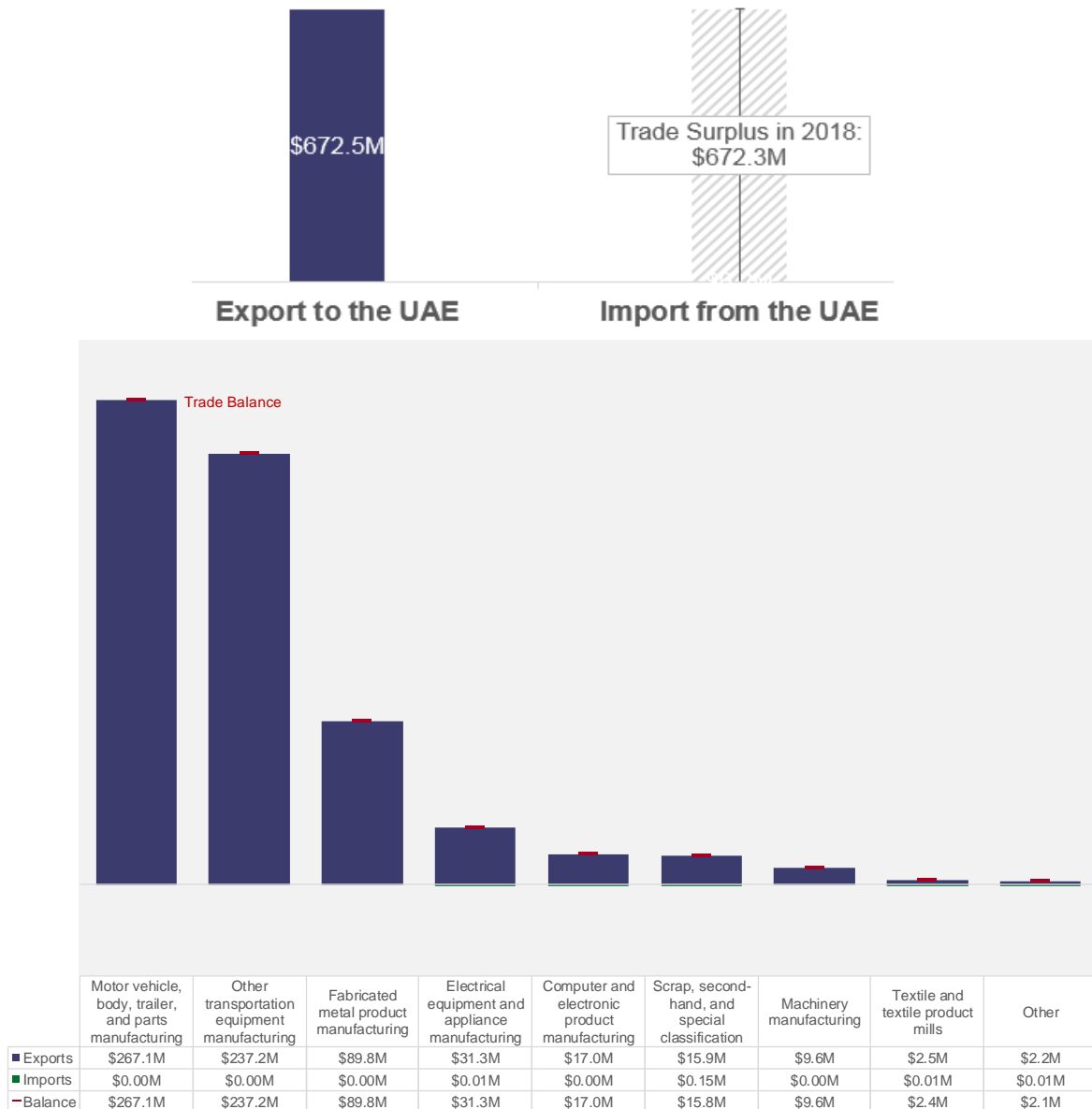

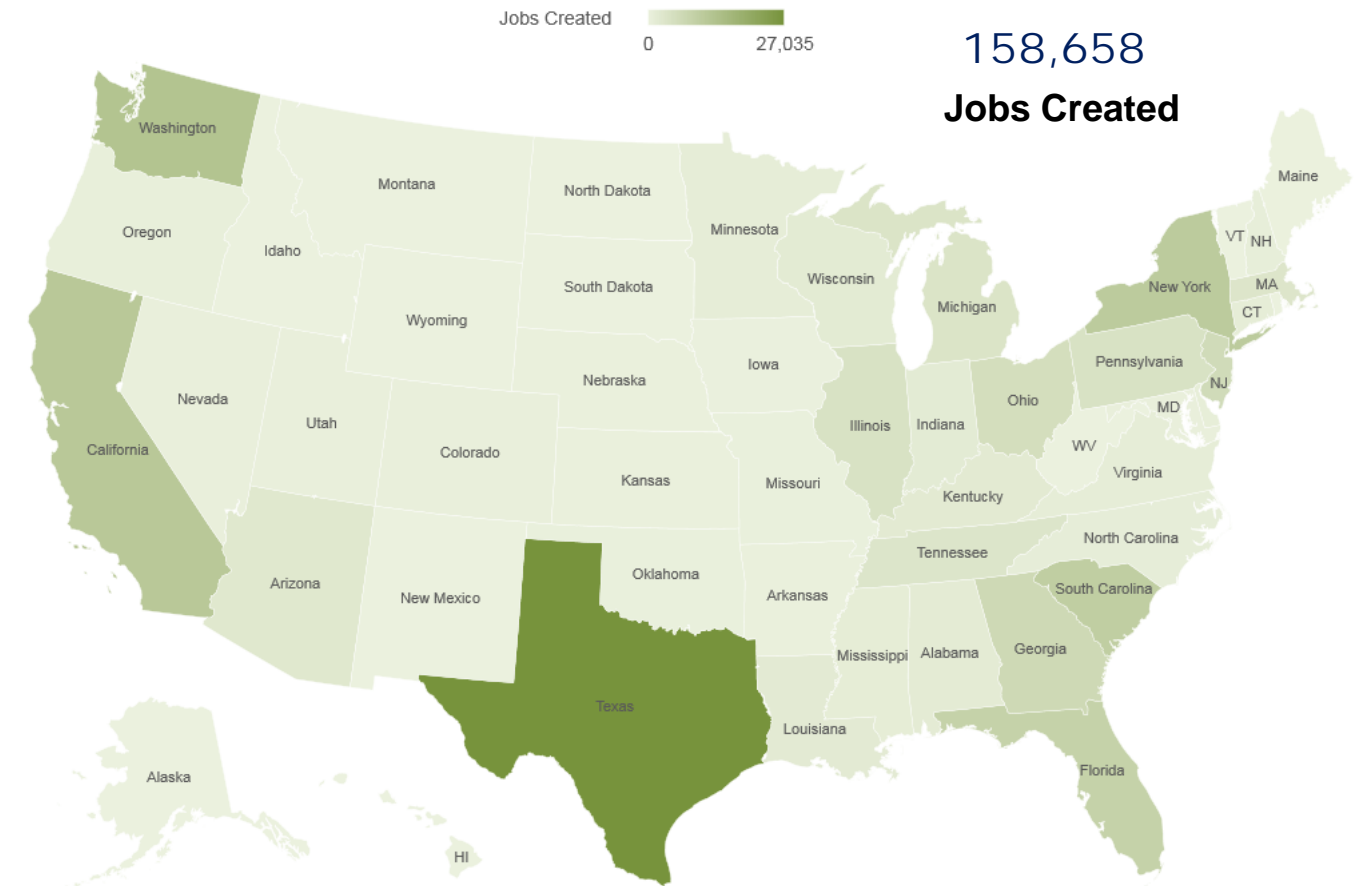
Exhibit I.5 | District of Columbia's Trade Surplus with the UAE by Sector

Positive U.S. Employment Driven by Exports to the UAE in 2018

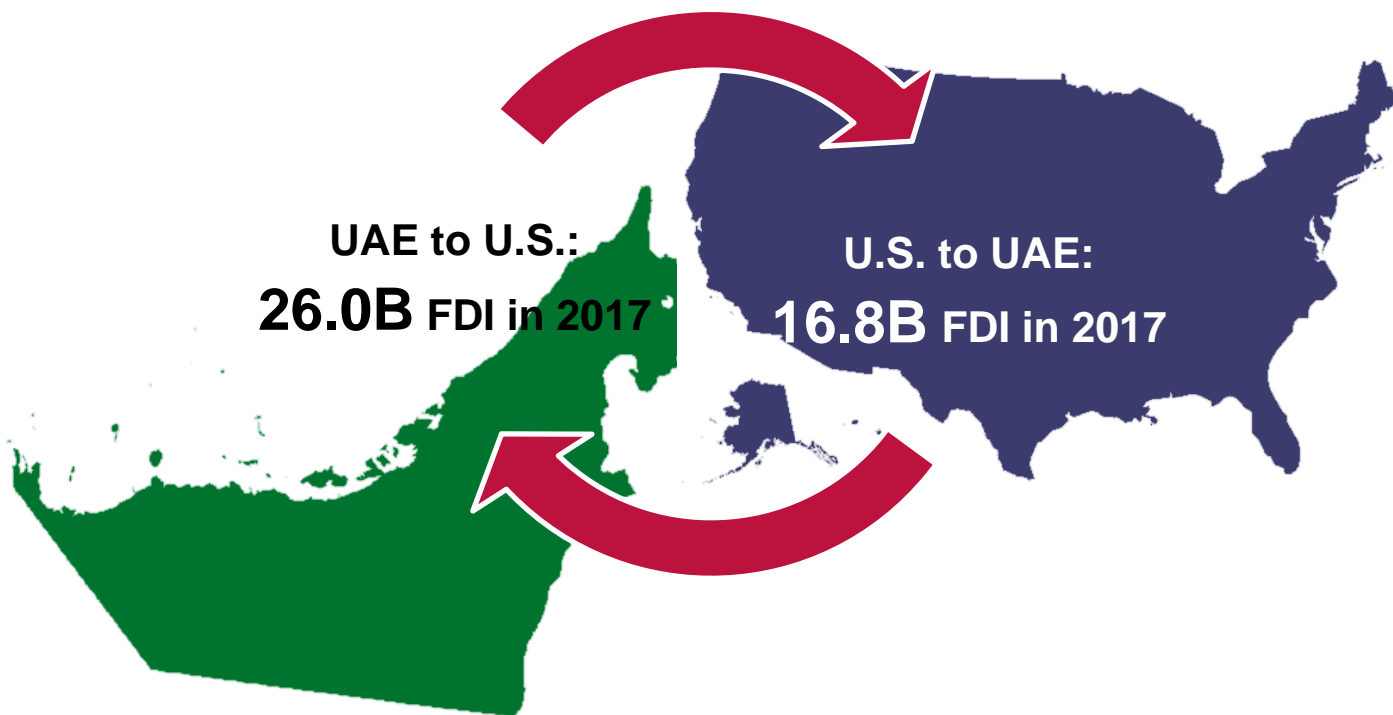

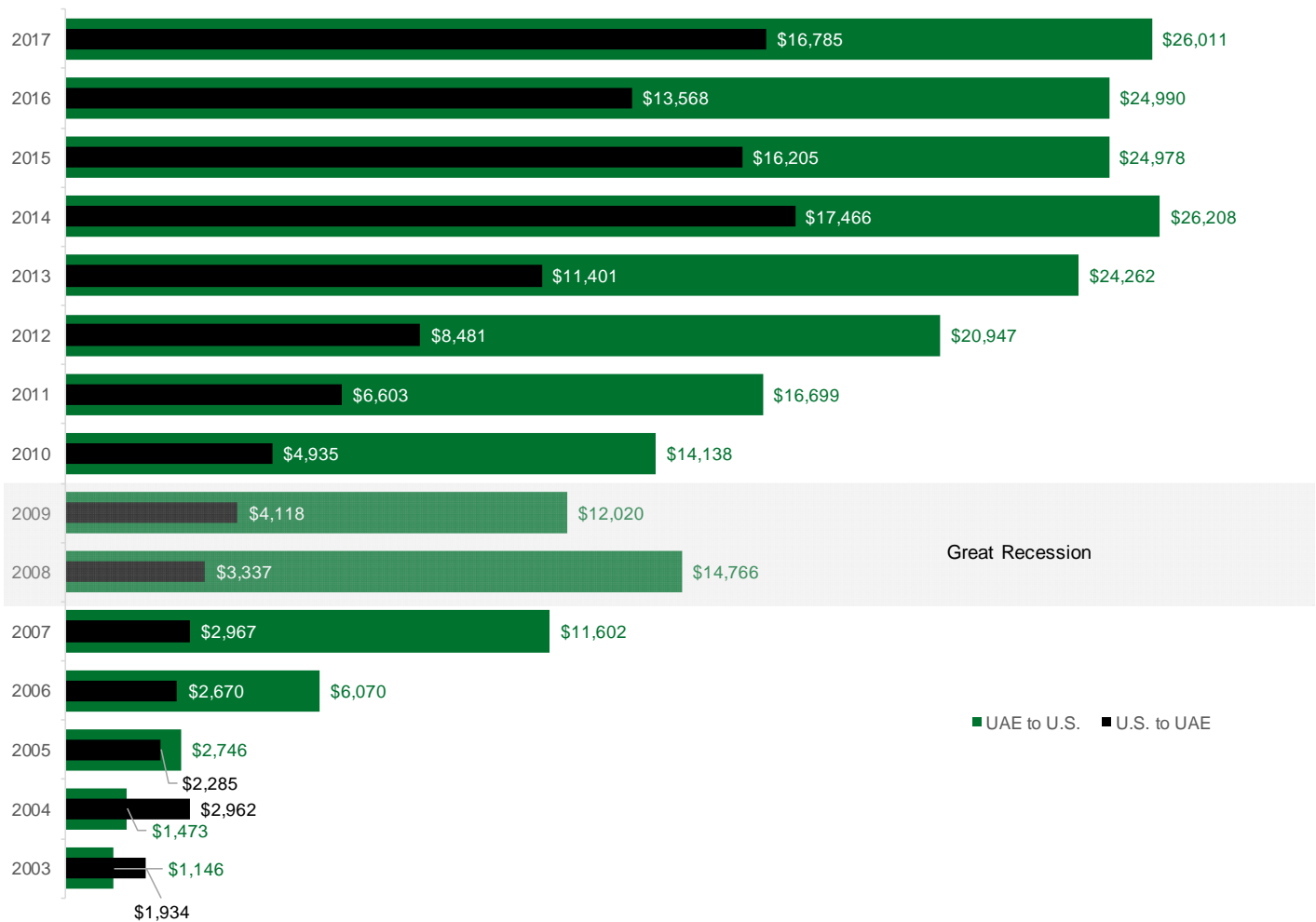

Exhibit IV.1 | Total UAE Investments by Year



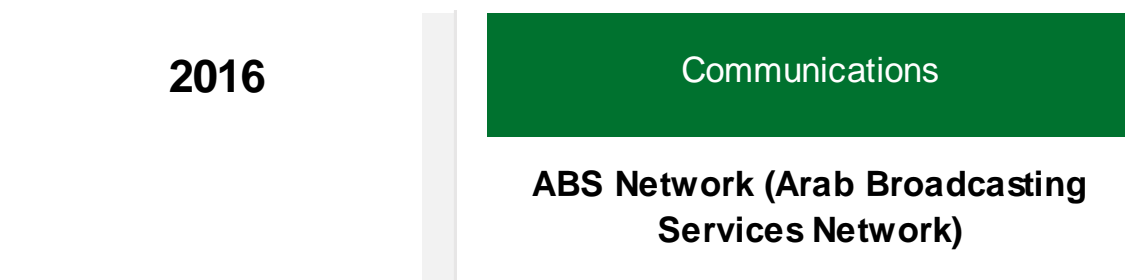
