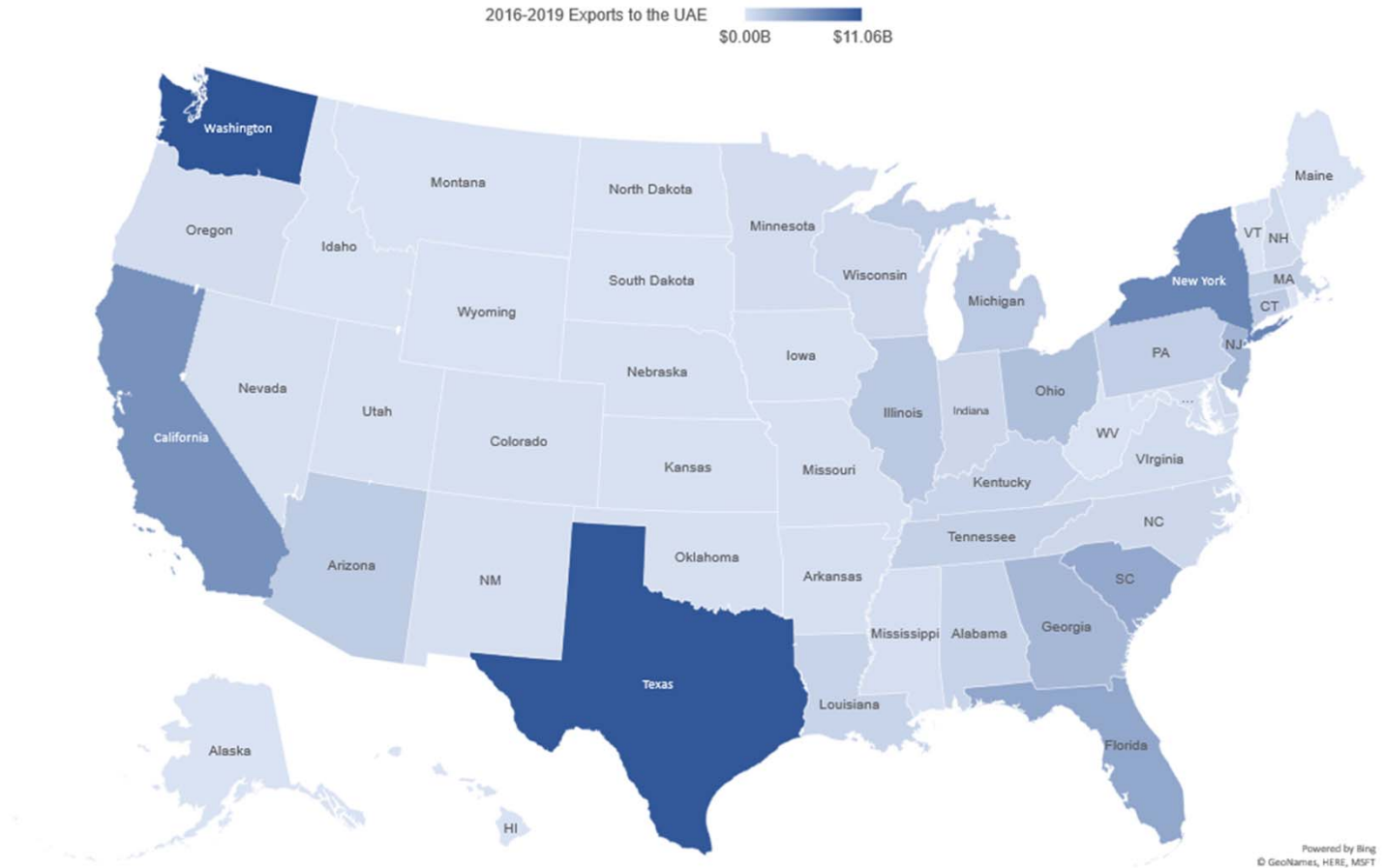

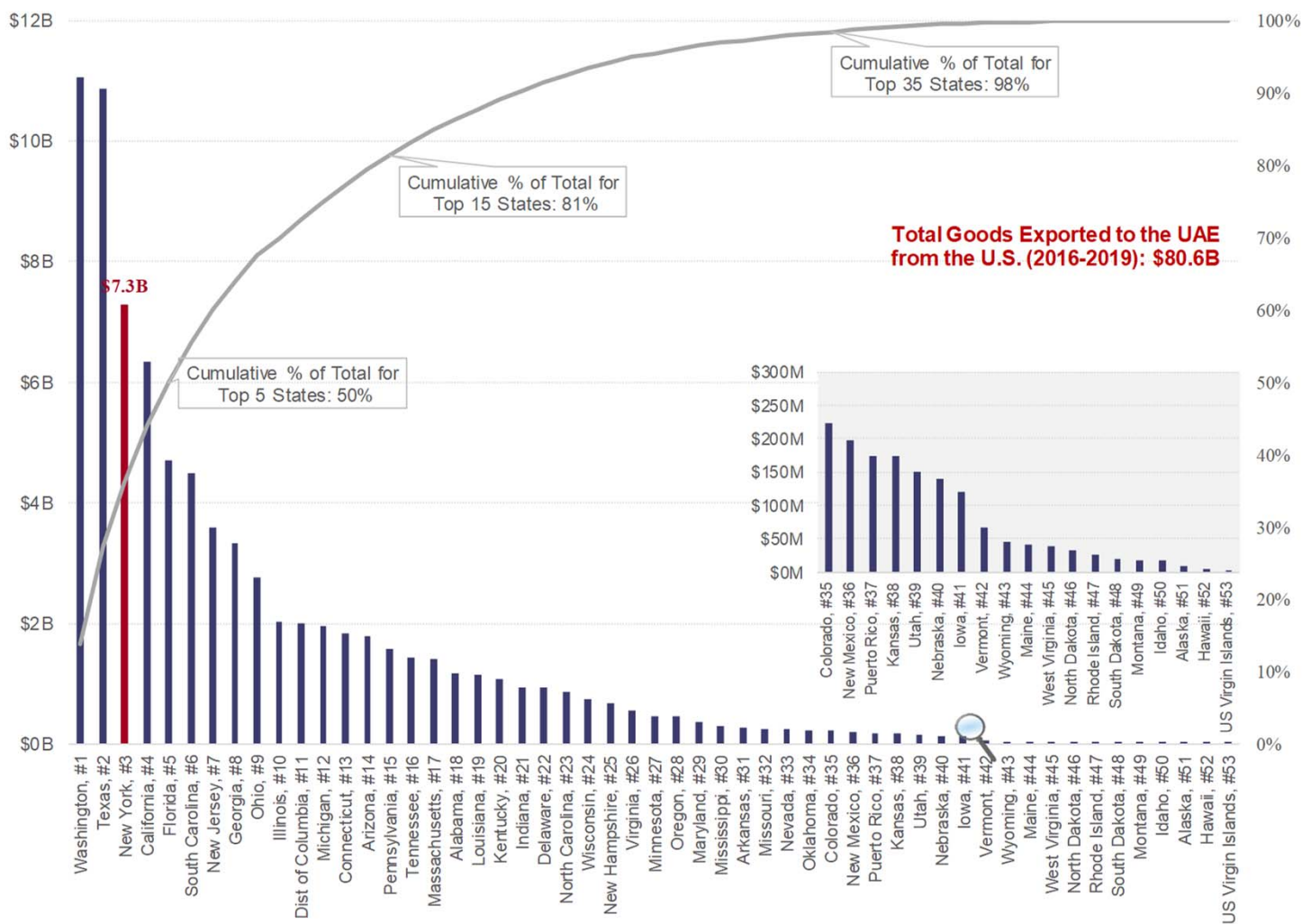

Exhibit I.1 | U.S. State Rankings of Exports to the UAE (\$ in Billions)



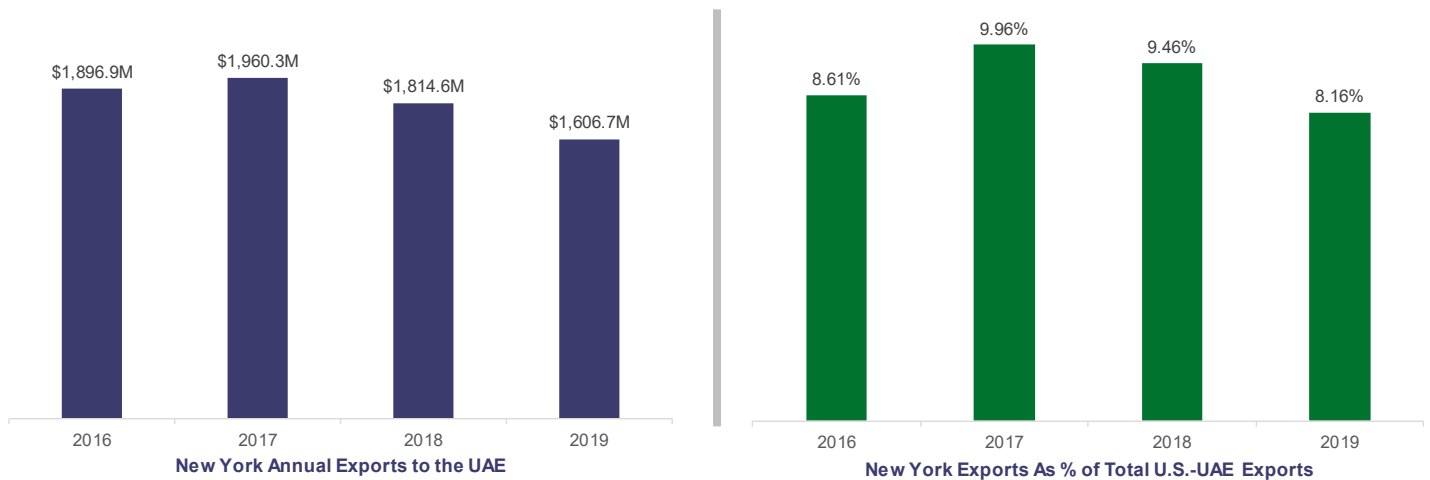

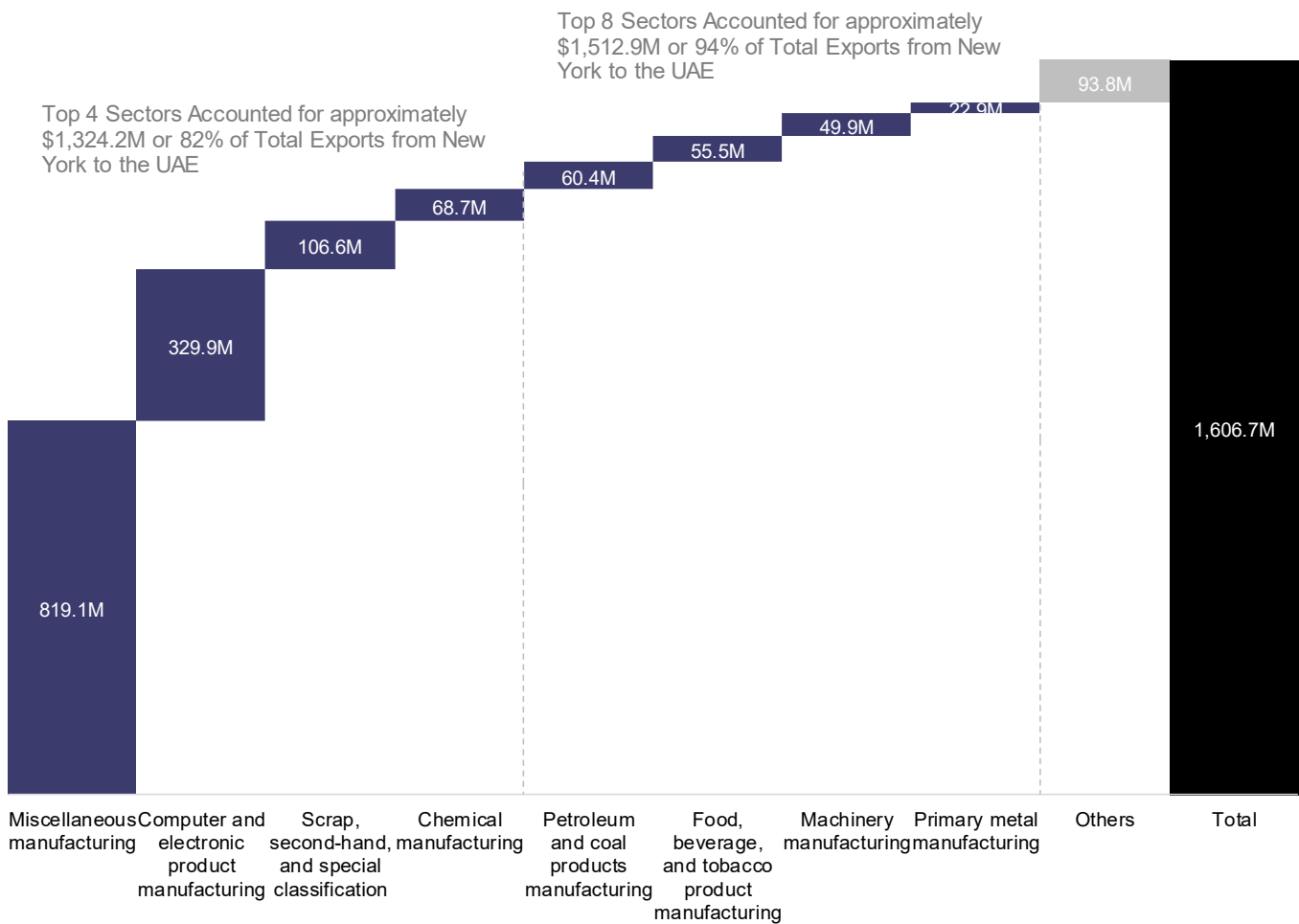

Exhibit I.3 | New York's Exporting Sectors in 2019



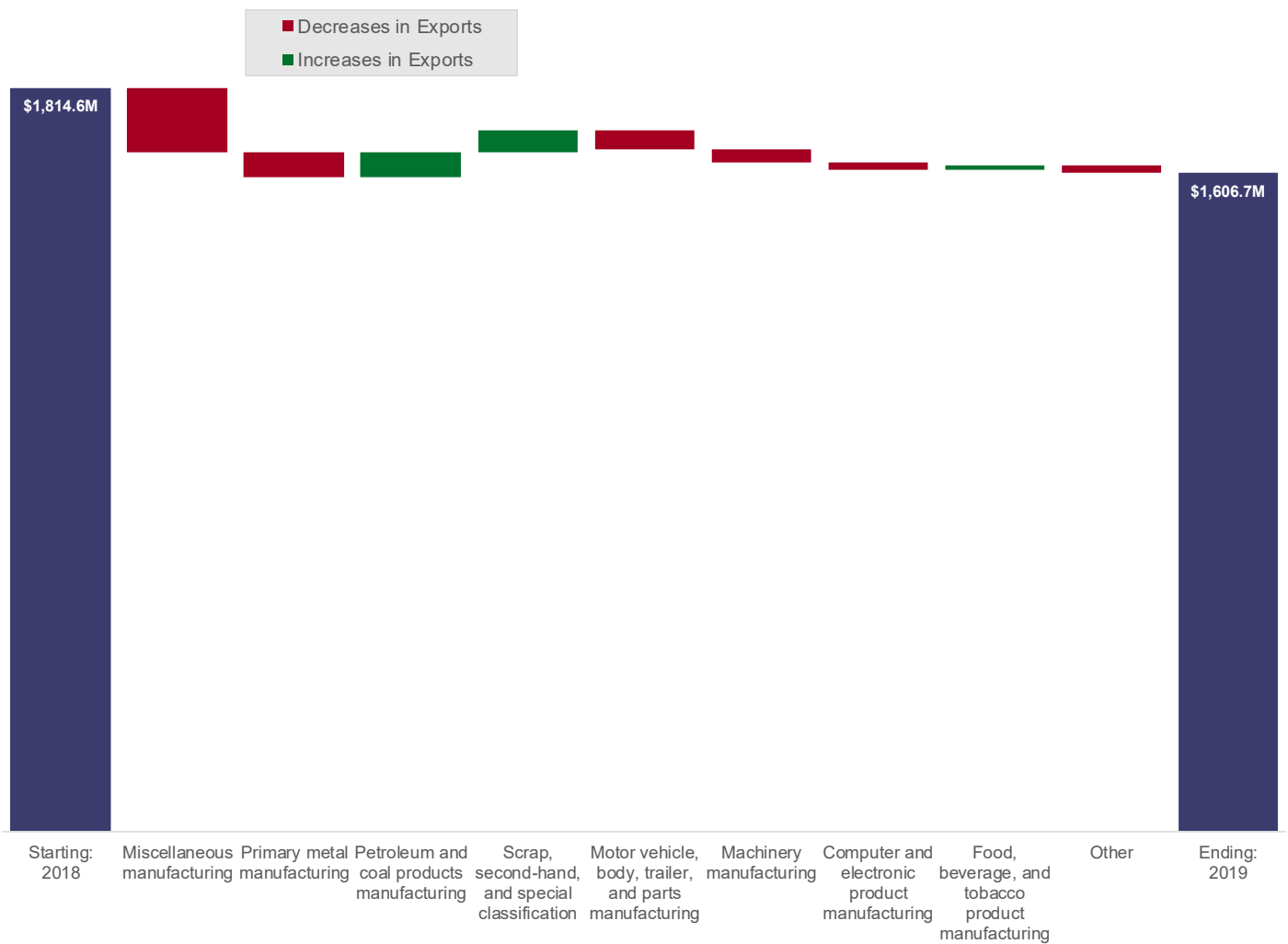

Exhibit I.4 | New York's Exporting Sector Movements From 2018 to 2019

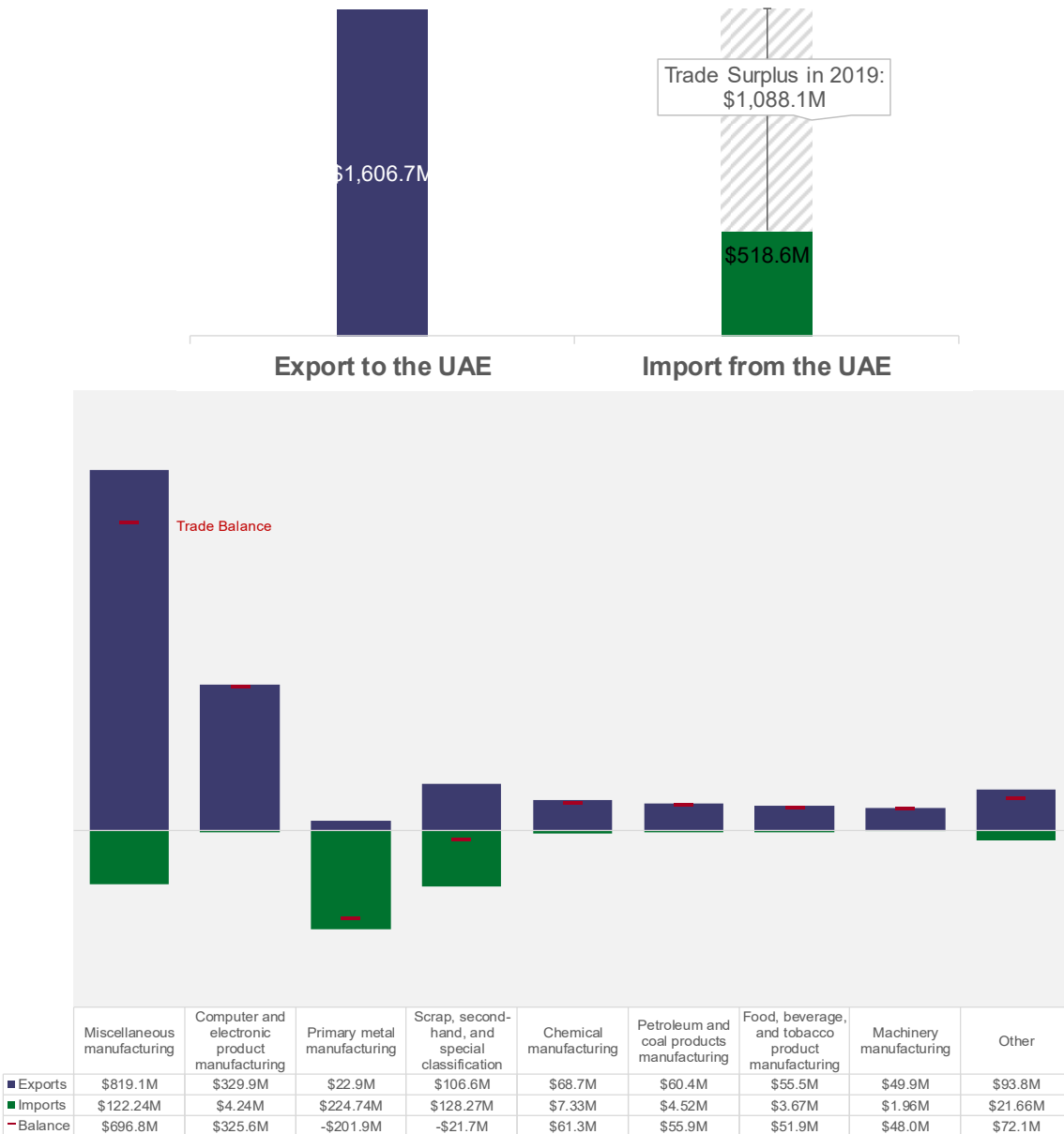

Exhibit I.5 | New York's Trade Surplus with the UAE by Sector



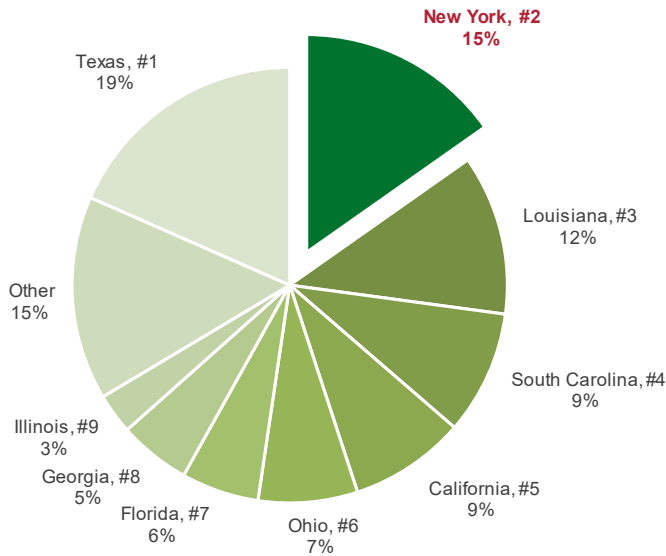

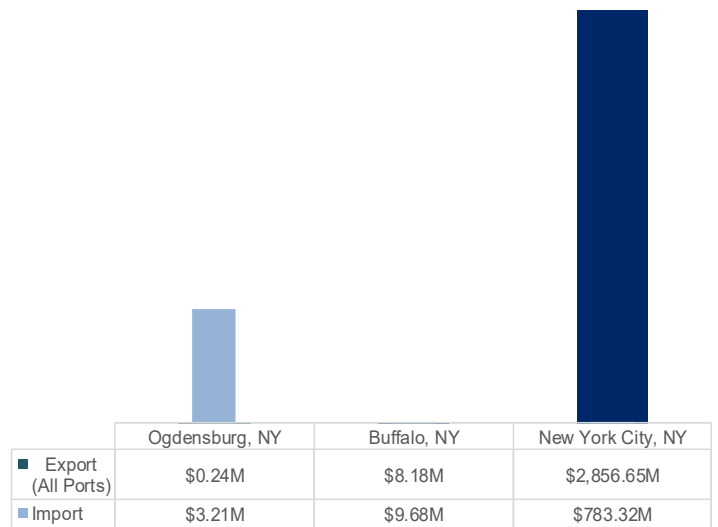

Total U.S.-UAE Port Activity

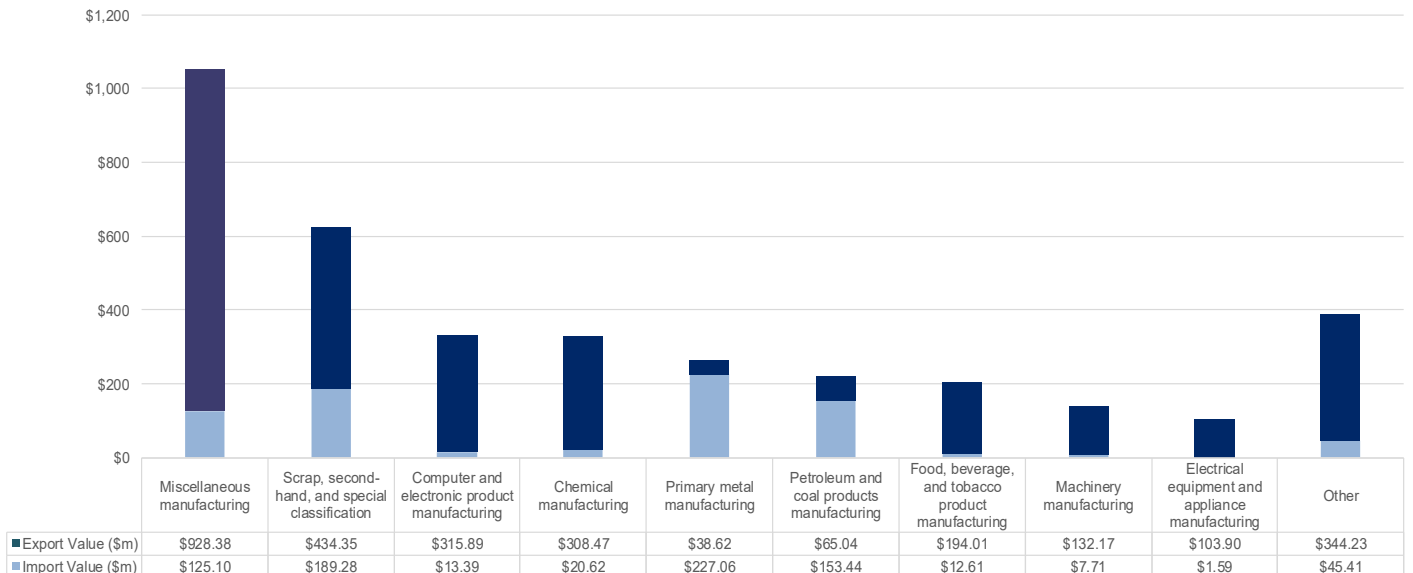


Port Activity by District

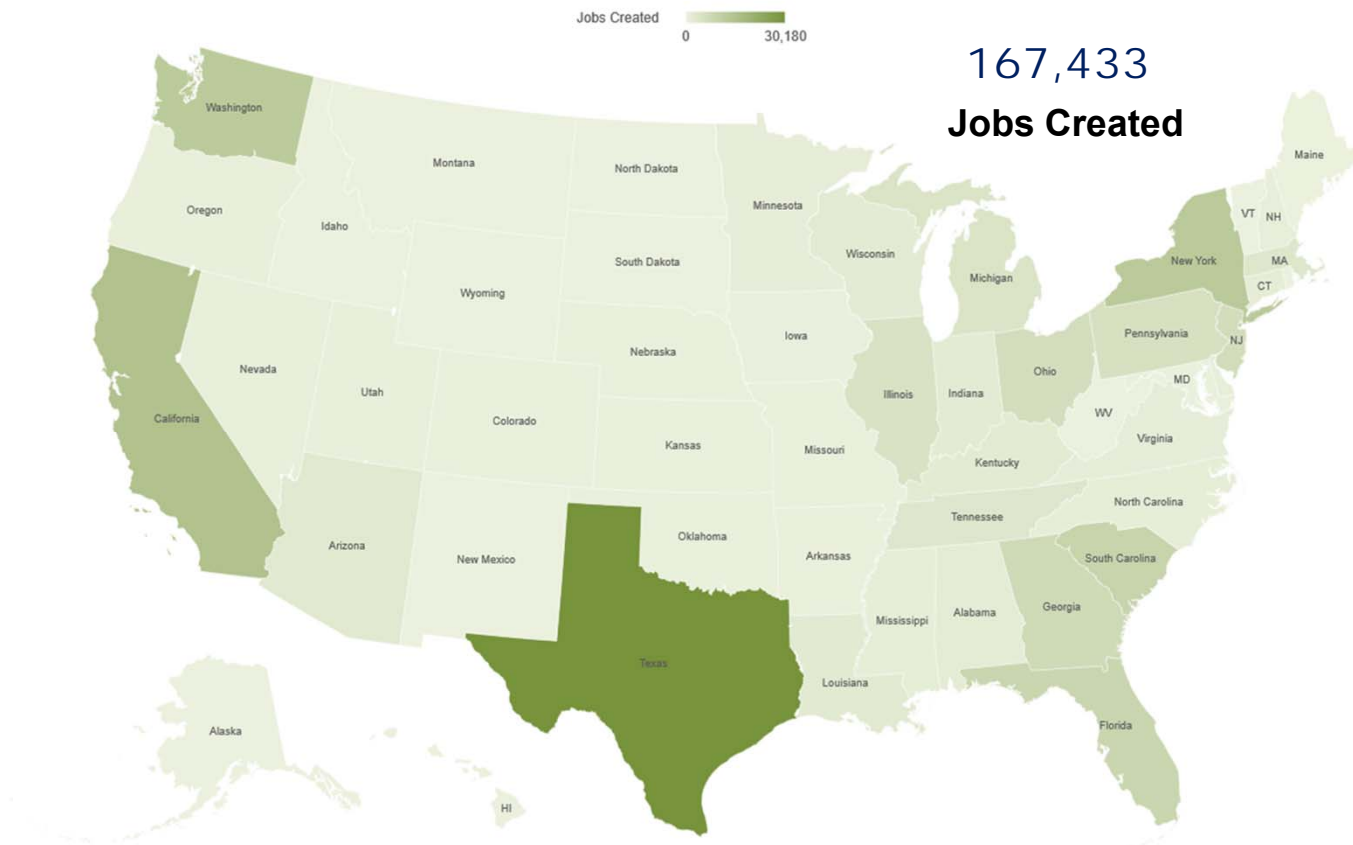

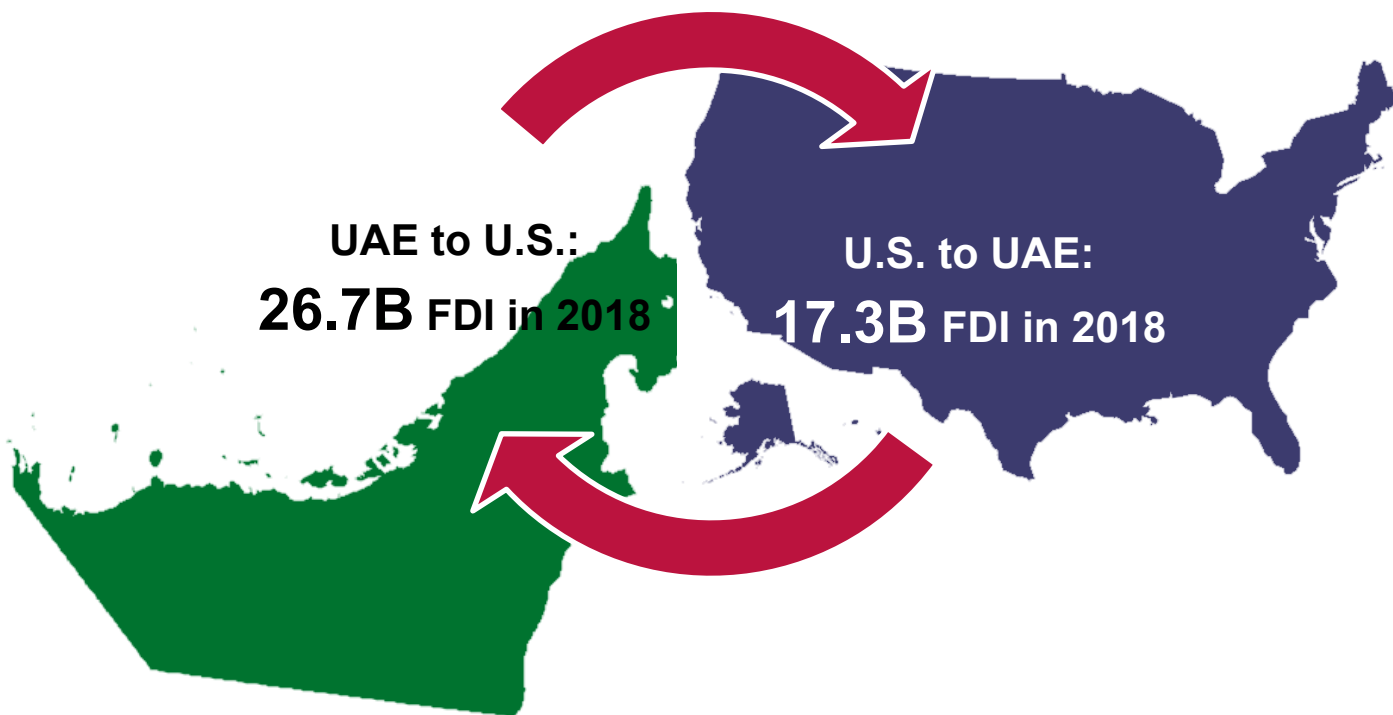

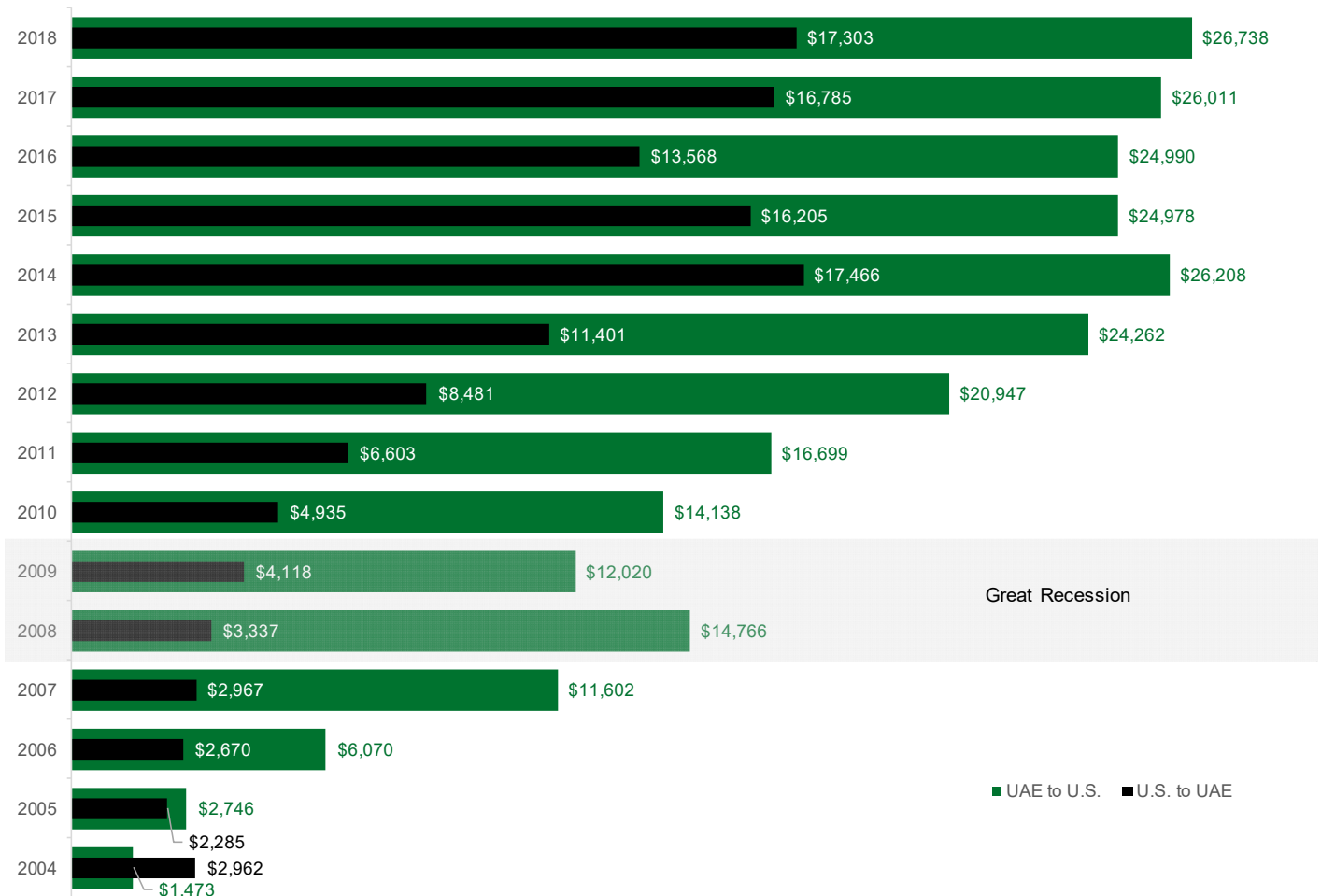
