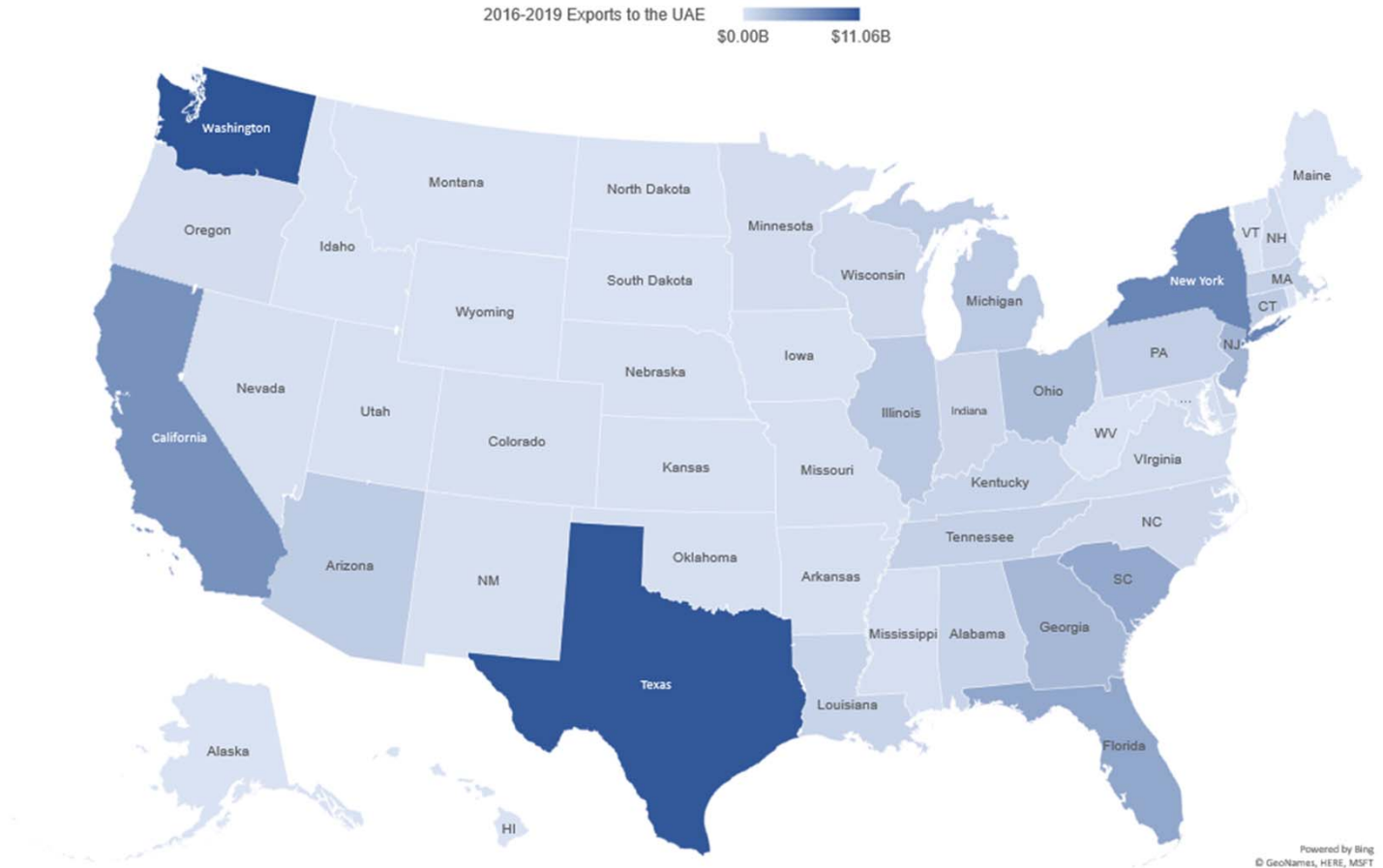

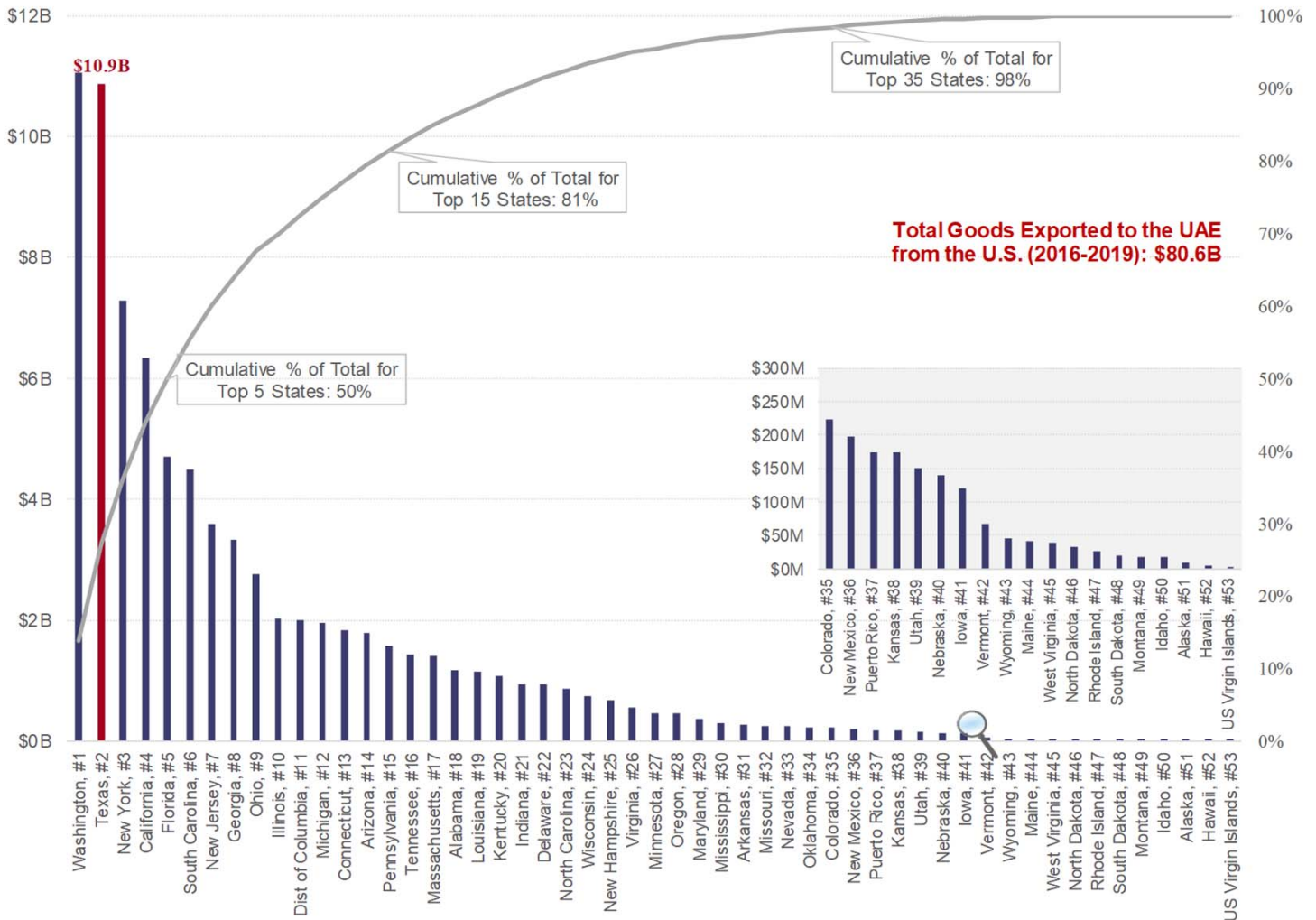

Exhibit I.1 | U.S. State Rankings of Exports to the UAE (\$ in Billions)



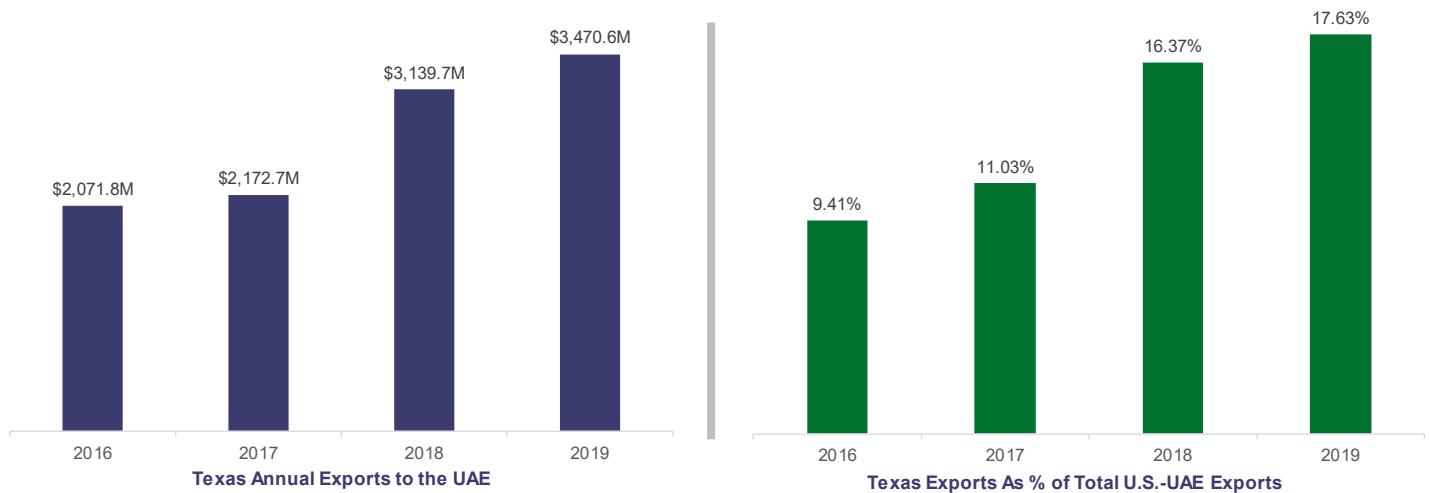

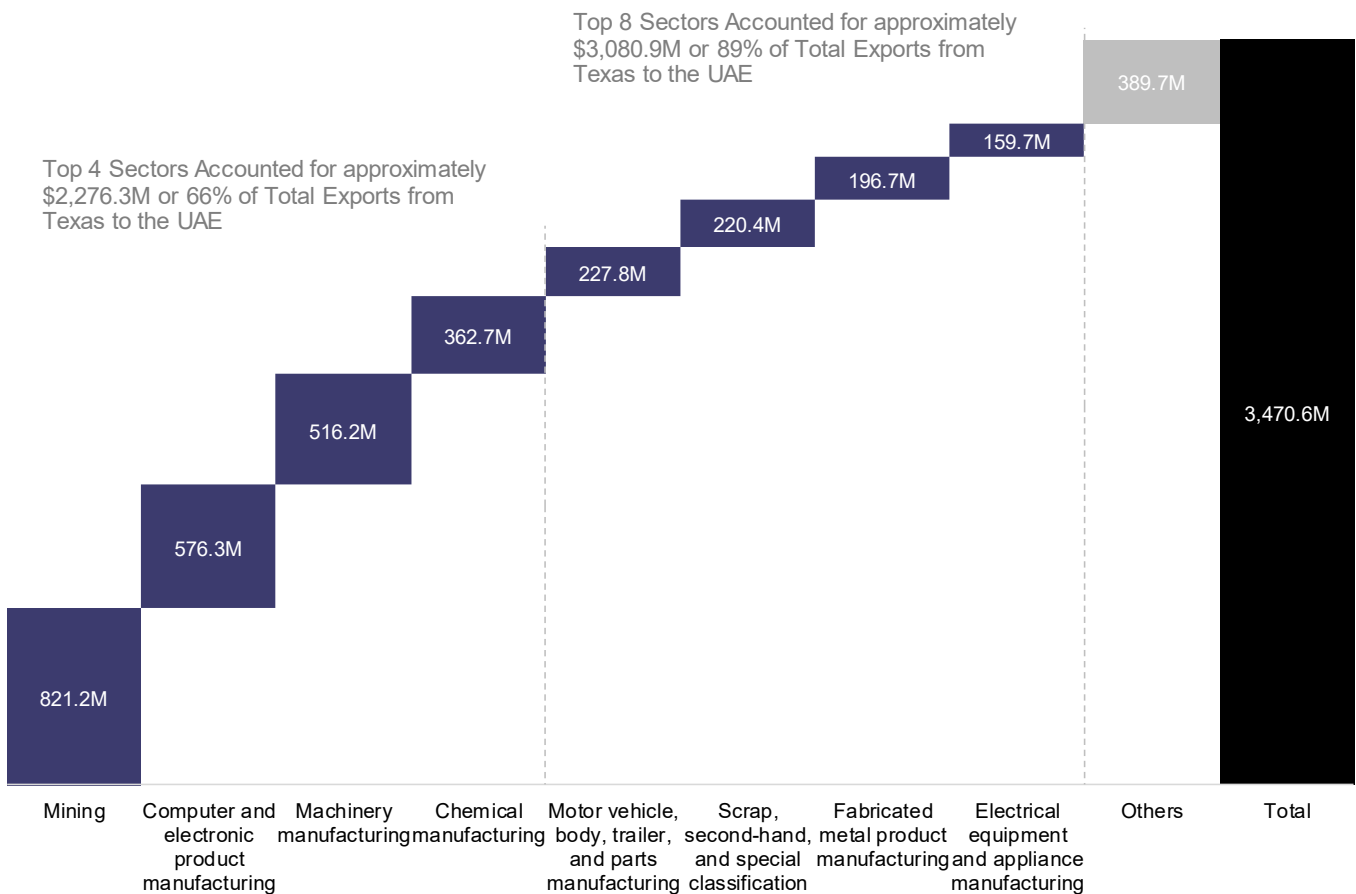

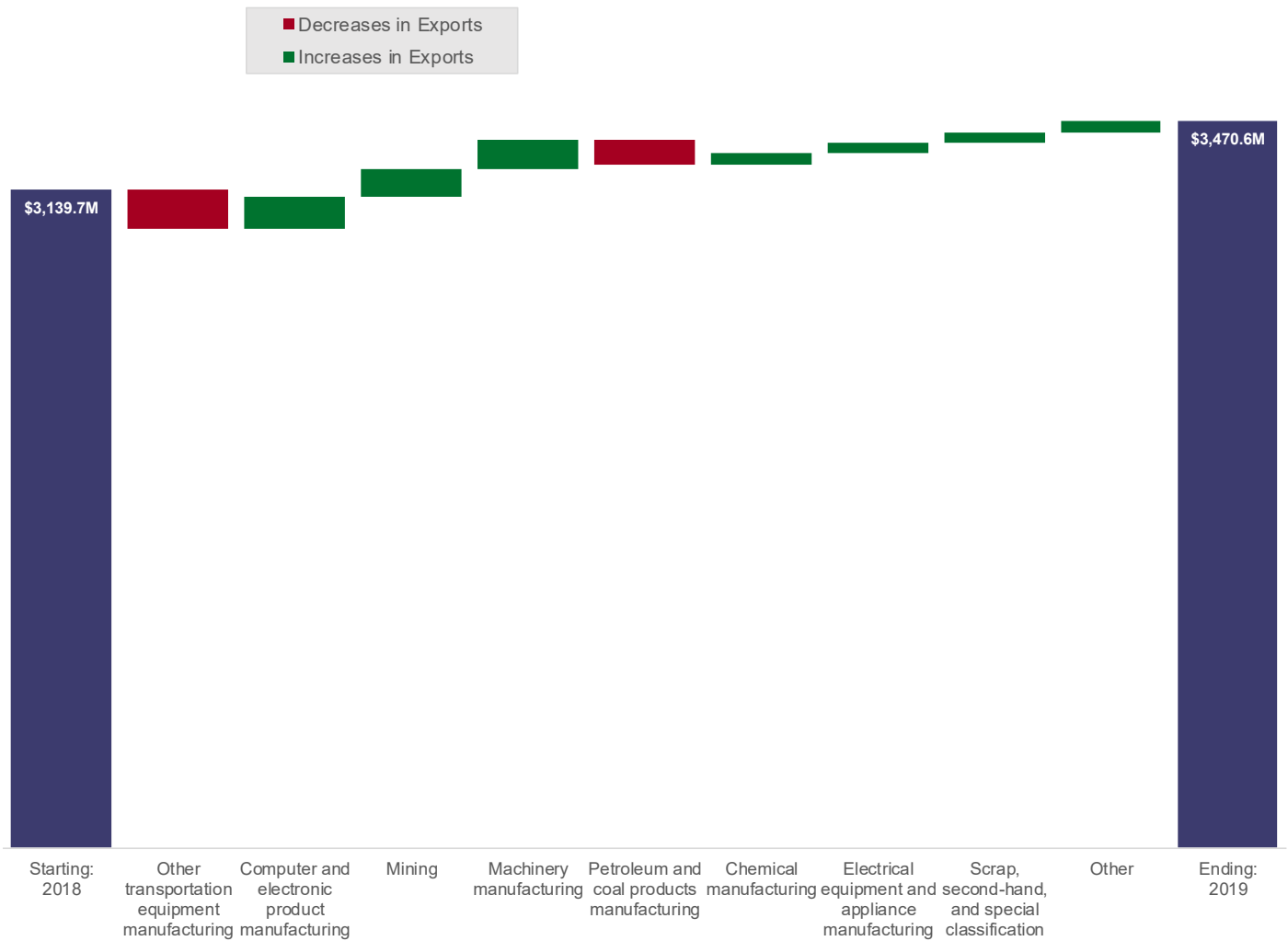

Exhibit I.4 | Texas's Exporting Sector Movements From 2018 to 2019

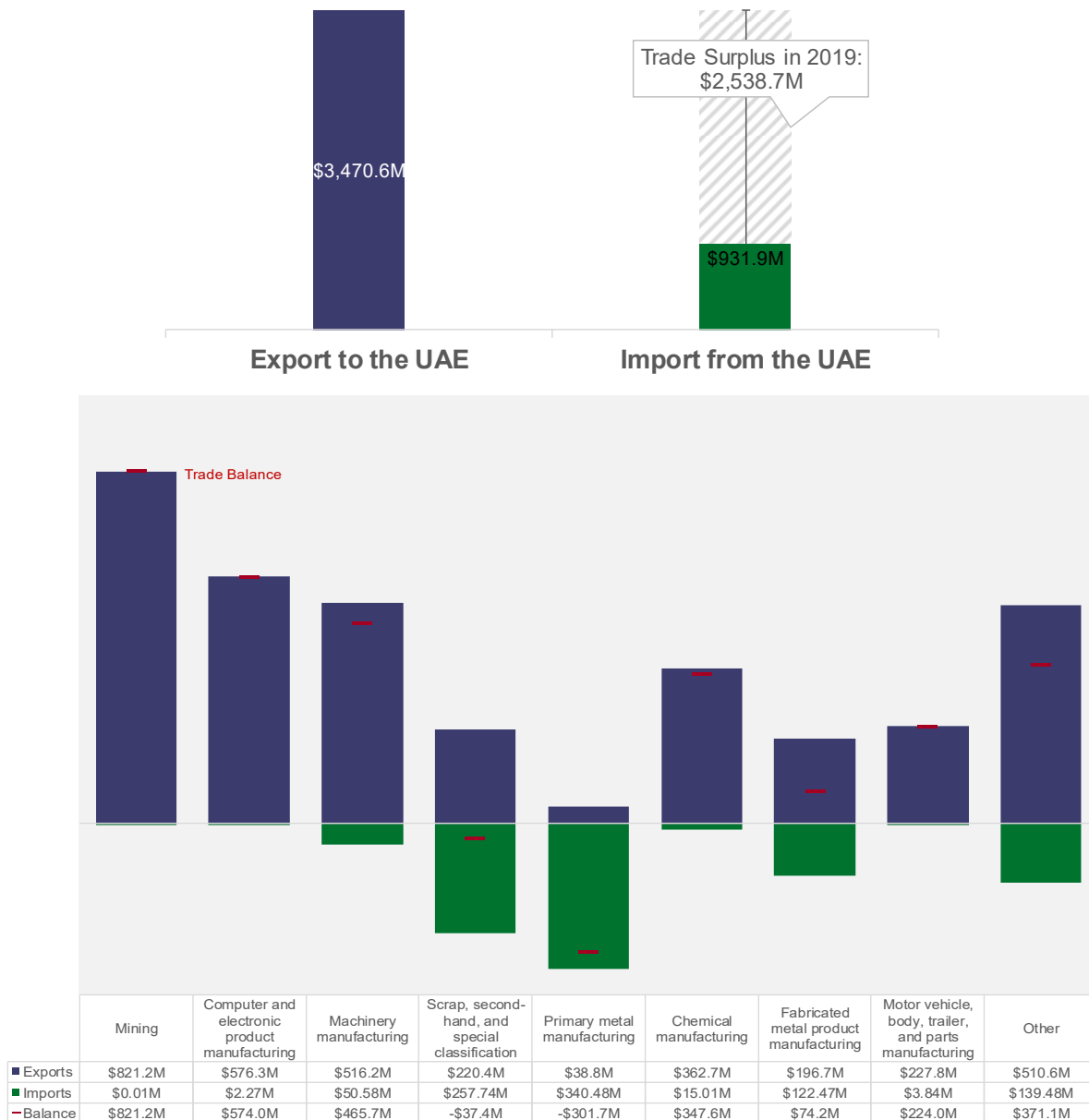

Exhibit I.5 | Texas's Trade Surplus with the UAE by Sector



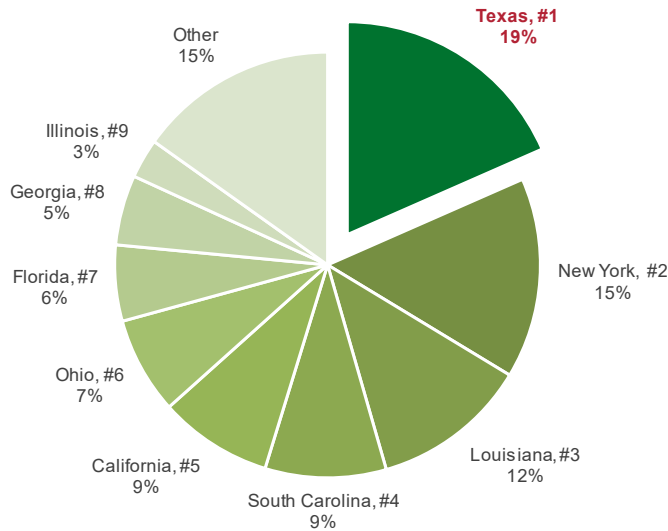
Texas – 2019 UAE Bilateral Port Activity



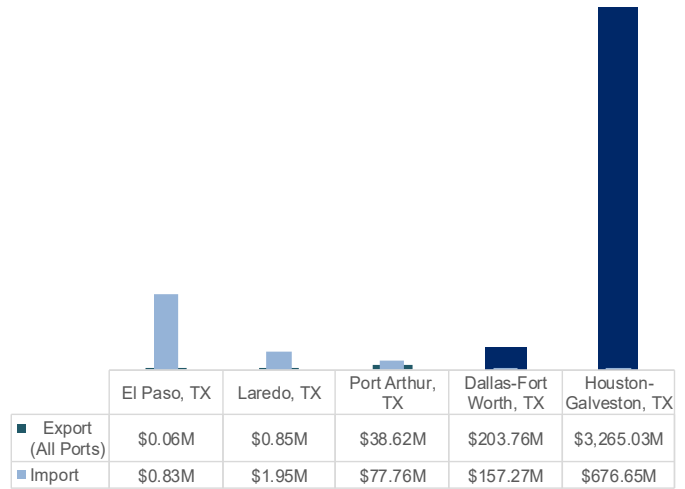

Total U.S.-UAE Port Activity

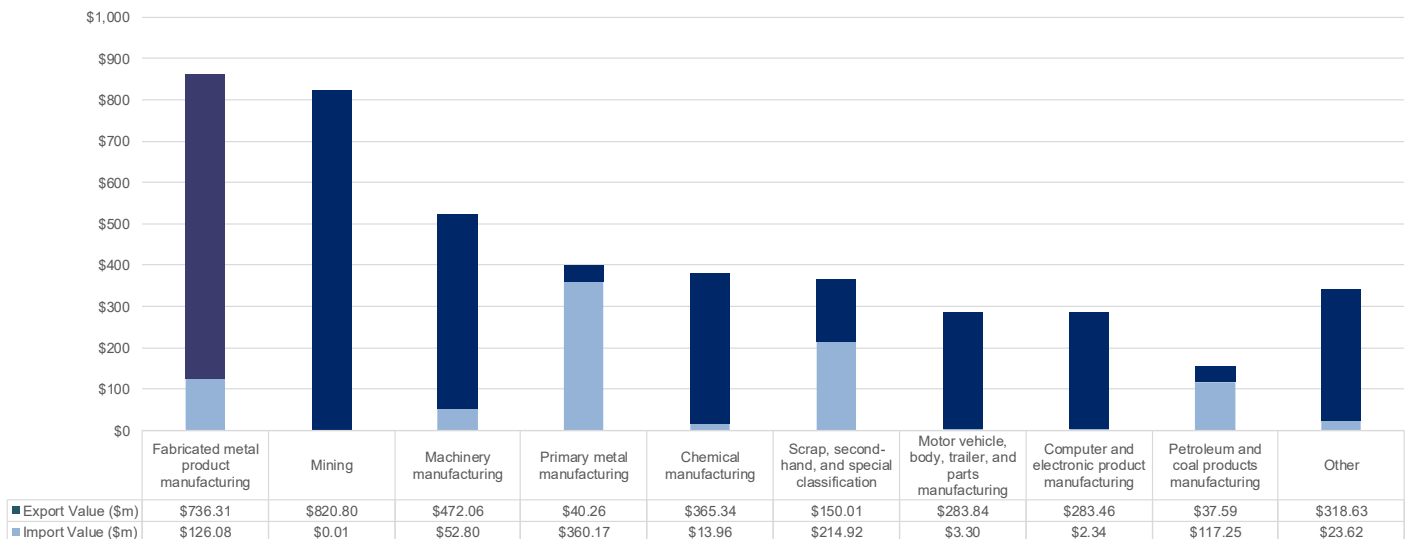


Port Activity by District

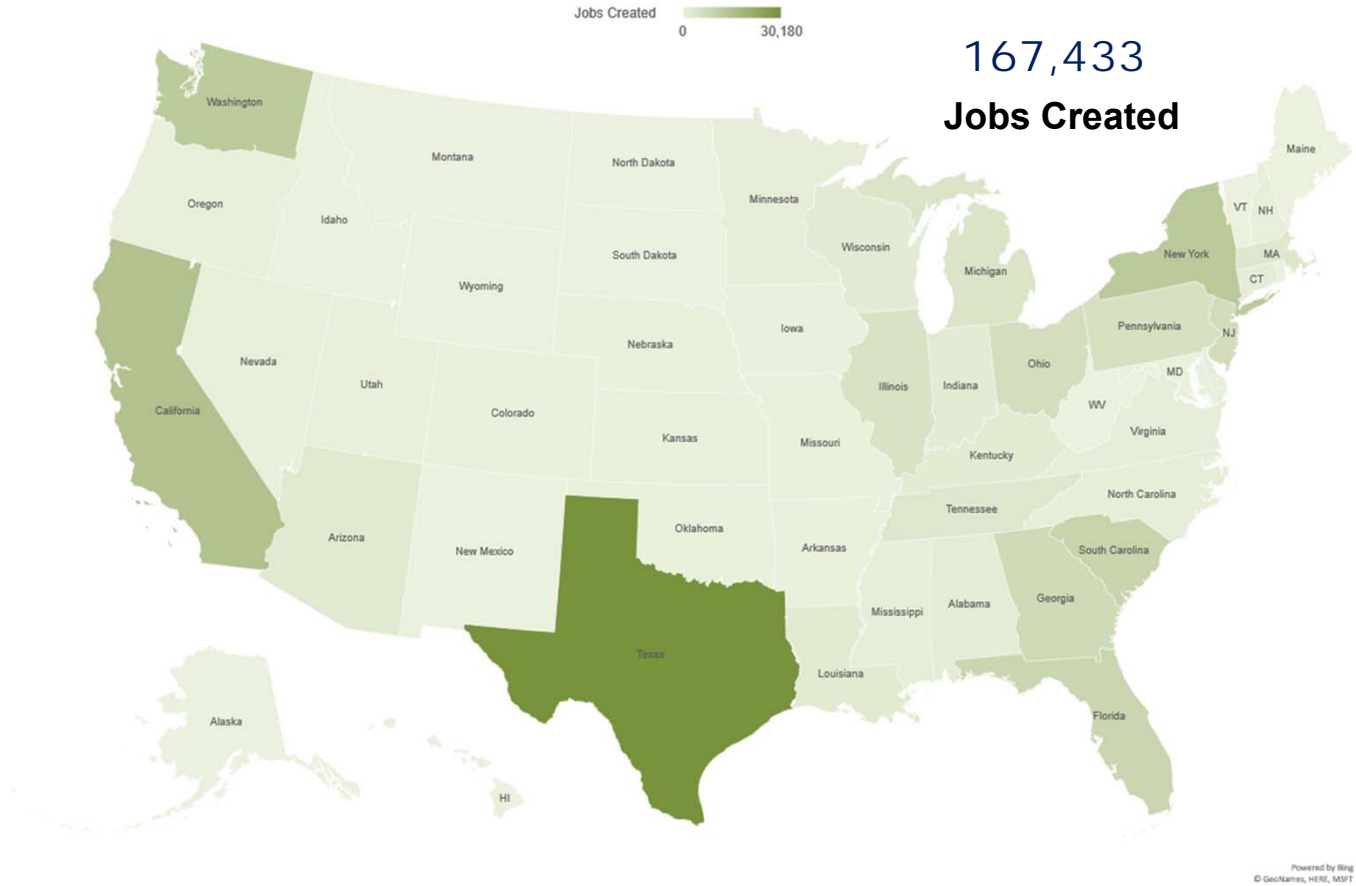

Positive U.S. Employment Driven by Exports to the UAE in 2019



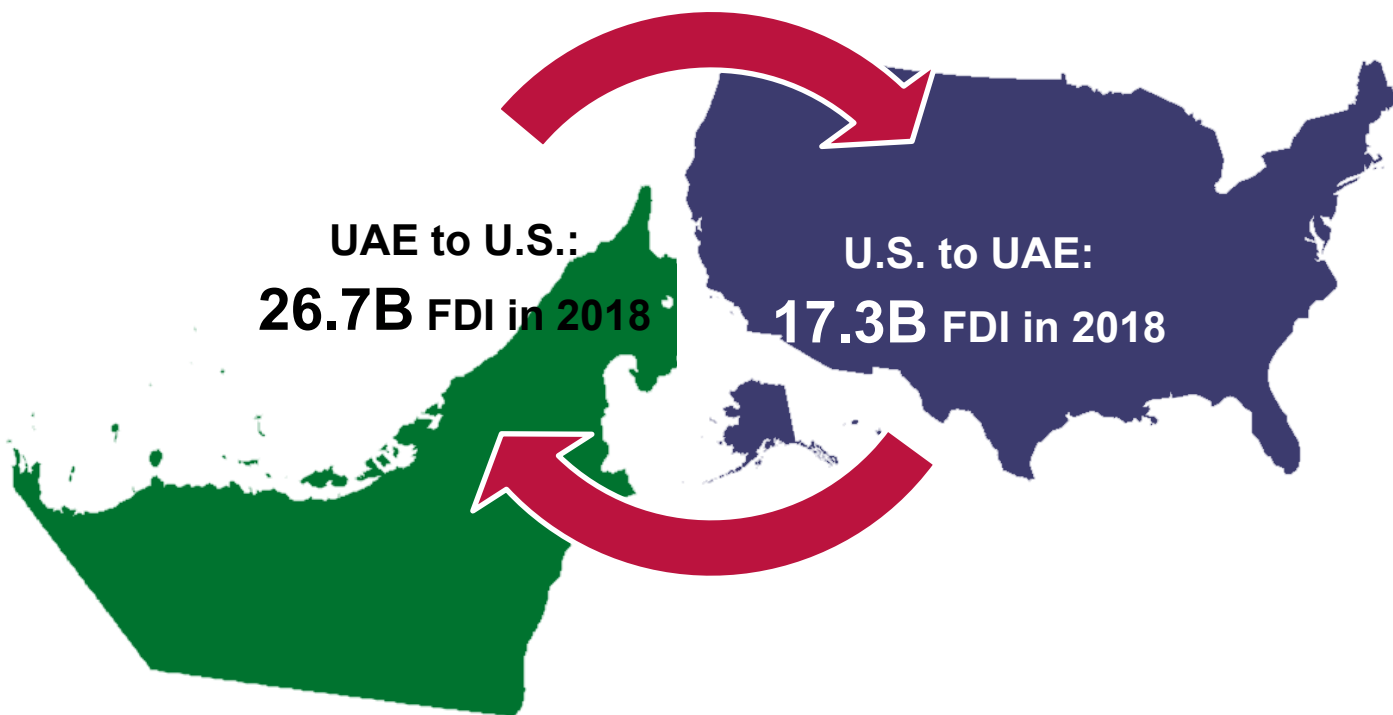

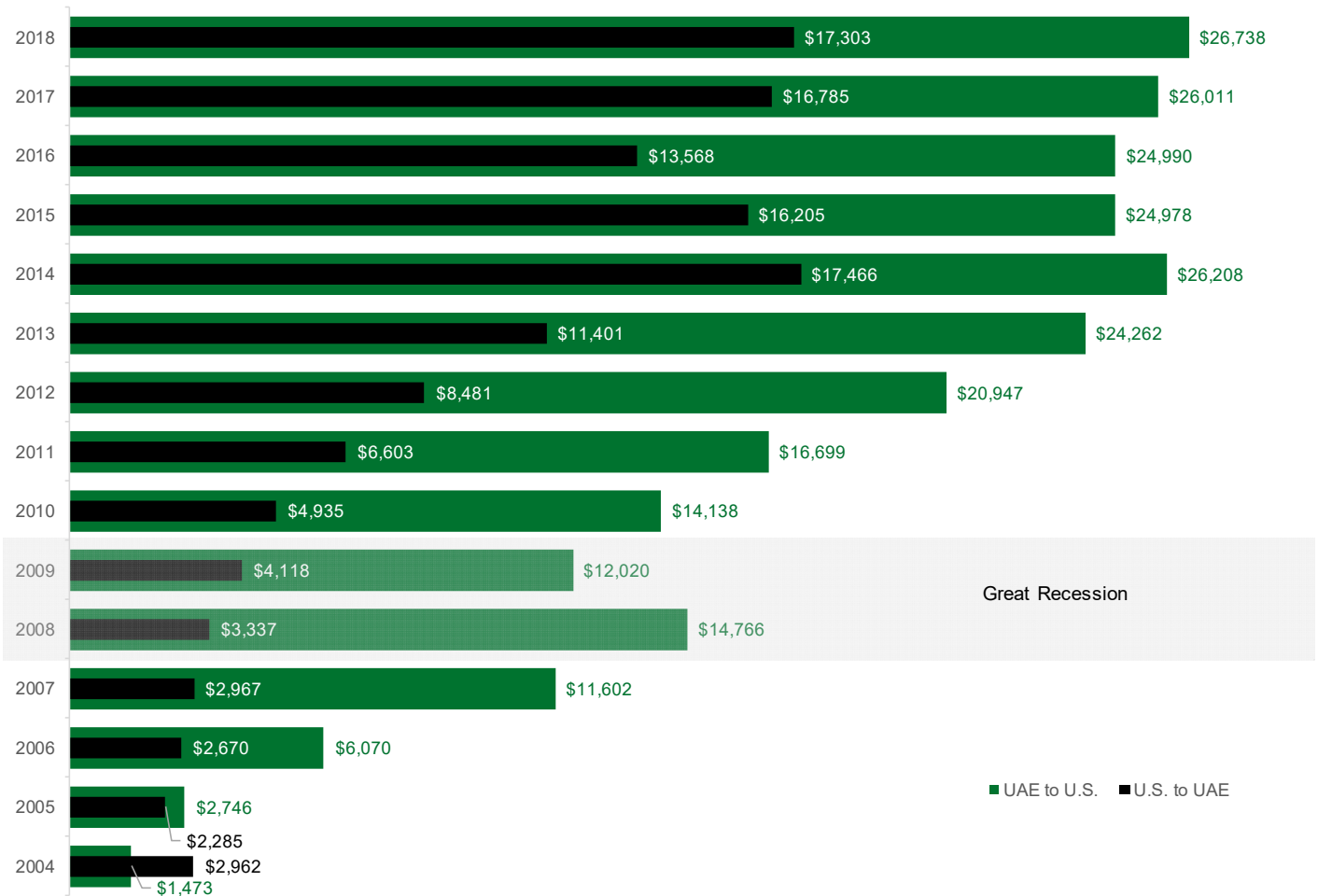
